## Course Details & Risk Assessment Q10/22

Harrietsham - Charing

Start in Marley Lane, Dickley Corner, Harrietsham at 18<sup>th</sup> kerb joint east of Marley entrance nearest to A.20 (TQ886528). Join the A.20 and proceed eastwards to turn at Charing RAB (M). Take the 4<sup>th</sup> exit to retrace on the A.20 to finish adjacent to Harrietsham Caravan Sales, approx. 315 metres after Harrietsham railway bridge, at 11<sup>th</sup> kerb joints west of lamp post KAMB27. (TQ870526)

Course last used in 2018 – 29 August for SFACC club event and 22 April for a KCA event. For 2024 this course is to only be used on a trial basis for San Fairy Ann CC limited club events so that feedback can be obtained during a small-scale event following traffic calming measures and housing development along the A20 in Harrietsham.

## Notes to be relayed to the riders in club events when they sign on.

Strictly NO PARKING on Marley's loading bay and in either of their two entrances.

No parking in Dickley Lane except for timekeepers.

Riders should not arrive at the start any more than 5 minutes before their allotted start time.

Riders must not restrict access to the entrances to the Marley works whilst waiting to start.

Riders to note that 3 additional pedestrian refuges have been installed on the A20 between Dickley Corner and the finish since 2021.

Riders to note that a 30mph speed limit has been installed on the A20 for the last half mile of the course.

Riders to note that the pedestrian crossing 20 metres after the finish line has now been changed to a Toucan style. Prior to 2021 this was a standard traffic light controlled pedestrian crossing.
