Adjacent to boundary of nos 3 & 4 Salters Lane (Terrace named South View)

- Riders must negotiate all Islands in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg 20 and the
 rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the islands and T-junctions if traffic
 conditions require this. Riders <u>MUST NOT</u> approach and encircle the islands using tri-bars. Remember –
 traffic on the island has priority over traffic (including riders) entering it. Any rider seen to be in breach
 of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary
 action.
- 2. <u>NOTE</u> The turn into Farm Lane approximately 1 mile from the finish line turns accutely back on itself so speed should be reduced accordingly. Riders <u>MUST NOT</u> swing out when approaching the junction and should ensure that they do not cross the centre line on Farm Lane after turning the corner.





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Local Regulations		
1	No parking at the start or finish. Vehicles must not be parked, however briefly, in any part of the access area to Mount Pleasant Nursing Home, opposite the finish. Riders must not stop at the finish but should continue on to the event headquarters where times will be displayed.	
2	Riders must negotiate Chelford Island in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg. 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this.	
3	Riders MUST NOT USE their tri-bars between the first bollard they pass on entering the island and the last bollard they pass leaving it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.	
4	Care At Road Junctions. Riders must exercise care at all junctions. Any competitor whose riding line causes him/her to cross the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.	

This document remains live and any changes to the items listed above or new hazards/risk that arise should be notified to the district committee at the earliest opportunity.
