Jem Hadar & VTTA (Yorks) bring to you a series of TT races, 1st week of March to get your racing season off to a start, 'breaking the ice' metaphorically rather than actually hopefully.

We bring to you a series of races to suit those leaning to road racing as well as the seasoned TT racers, with a 2-up TTT event and a road bike only event to add to the regular TT race.

We've added a steel framed bike race for those wanting to go 'old school' although a brand new steelie will be just as suitable. To add we have a fixed wheel only event for those who enjoy the feeling of purity with fixed wheel gearing.

To add to the diversity of the event and increase the interest we've added a Tricycle only TT event on this safe course with wide roads and minimal traffic as well as a Tandem event, with our own multiple Olympic tandem champion often frequenting these roads as solo as well as on tandems.
