Course MH26

Shadworth - Paradise Bank - A181 Silent Bank (0.96 miles)

START on minor road, Paradise Bank approximately 20 metres from Junction with road from Shadworth to Ludworth.

Proceed South, uphill for 0.4 miles before passing Ox Close Farm entrance on the left. After a slight dip in road, continue for a further 0.4 miles to FINISH at marked drain, 100 metres before T-junction with A 181.

Additional Information

Road surface conditions may change depending on the season, weather or condition of the road. It is the riders' responsibility to ride in such a manner that allows them to ride safely and with consideration to other road users at all times. Head down riding is dangerous.

It is the responsibility of the rider to check the Risk Assessment on the day to be aware of any extra hazards or changes they should be aware of.

Every Competitor MUST have, fixed to their machine, both a front and rear facing, working light. These must be clearly visible (Regulation 14)

Every rider MUST wear a helmet that conforms to current Safety Standards (Regulation15) and it is their responsibility to ensure it fits correctly and is in good condition/undamaged.

Note to organiser: All of the above listed information to be included in the start sheet.

Assessment Date: August 2022

Safety notes:

 Vehicles of competitors / officials / marshals / helpers to be parked safely and without hindrance to other road users.

Riders:

- Keep strictly to the correct side of the road at all times.
- Riders be aware of small farm entrances, drives and junctions on the course that have not been specifically highlighted, but may have traffic entering the course on the day.
- No U-turns to be made in the vicinity of the Timekeeper.
- No dismounting in the finishing area.
- Take care descending after the race and avoid hindering other riders.
- Do not congregate at the start line more than 5 minutes before your start time.

Note to organiser: The above information to be posted either at the signingon area in the case of club events or included in the Start Sheet in the case of Open Events.

Risk Assessment

All officials / marshals / helpers to wear fluorescent jackets or high visibility clothing. Marshals are to be briefed as to the extent of their roles / duties prior to the event.
