NOTE: THE TURN IS NOW AT THE LEEDS RAB NOT THE HOLLINGBOURNE RAB
NOTE: THE FINISH IS NOW JUST PAST THE RAILWAY BRIDGE NEXT TO THE M20 BRIDGE

<u>Start</u> by litter bin in the layby on A.20 west of Broomfield turning (*Turn left out of Harrison Drive into Church Road and then right on to the A20. The start is about 2.3 miles towards Maidstone, just beyond the M20 flyover. Please allow 15 minutes to ride there, settle & be ready to start.)* 

Proceed east via Charing RAB to Orchard Heights RAB, Ashford (12.138 miles). **Turn** and retrace on A20 via Charing RAB to Leeds RAB RAB (25.250 miles). **Turn** and repeat route to Orchard Heights RAB (38.350 miles). **Turn** and retrace on A20 to **Finish** at white mark painted on kerb on the north side of railway bridge just short of Chegworth Road. (50 miles)

Riders should note that there are traffic light controlled pedestrian crossings on outward and return journey through Harrietsham and Charing.

## **Headquarters**

The HQ is Harrietsham Village Hall, Harrison Drive, Church Road, Harrietsham ME17 1AP.

Church Road is on the left as you pass through Harrietsham on the A20 travelling towards Ashford and just before the railway bridge. Harrison Drive is 0.2 of a mile along Church Road on the right. The hall will be open from 5:45am for signing on. Parking is available at the Hall.

#### **NOTES FOR RIDERS**

**Numbers** will be in the event headquarters hall and will be personally issued to each rider after they have signed on. Riders should refer to Regulation 16 - which states that 'the number should be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear when in the normal riding position'. Numbers can be exchanged for a drink on completion of their ride.

NOTE: Under new requirements introduced in 2017, riders are also required to sign out when returning their number to the HQ.

Please keep noise to a minimum to avoid unnecessary disturbance of local residents.

Please remove racing shoes before entering the hall.

No rider should use a turbo trainer or rollers in the HQ parking area or adjacent roads and you will be asked to stop using them if found doing so. Failure to comply rider risks disqualification from the event.

**Do Not** perform U turns in the start and finishing areas and do not use these areas as a public toilet as offenders risk disqualification.

**Rider Feedback Forms -** Riders should note that these forms are available at the hall by the signing on desk, and can be used by riders/marshals with comments and suggestions that could significantly improve safety.

<u>All Junior/Juvenile riders MUST wear recognised standard protective headgear.</u> In the interests of safety it is recommended that all riders should wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.
