Rider Instructions: <u>Numbers will be available at the HQ. You must sign on when collecting</u> <u>your number. Pin rear number low down. Riders must also sign out when leaving numbers.</u>

Directions to Start: The start is directly outside the HQ on the opposite side of the B5053.

Warm-Up: Riders are requested not to use the B5053 to warm up as this could interfere with competing riders. We recommend using Leek Road, between Warslow and The Mermaid.

Please: Only the Timekeepers' cars at the Start and Finish.

Parking at the HQ is limited, please be considerate and leave the spaces for race officials.

Please do not park on the B5053 to avoid obstructing riders on the course. We recommend parking on Leek Road between Warslow and the Mermaid. Please avoid warming up on stationary bikes directly outside any houses, or obstructing the footpath.

Course J8/25

Start: On the B5053 adjacent to a wooden seat set in the Warslow church wall opposite Warslow Village Hall.

Proceed towards Longnor:-

Longnor [4.2 miles]

Left at the Horseshoe Public House to:-

Royal Cottage [8.4 miles]

Left on the A53 after approximately 80 yards left again along 'Morridge' following the road alignment at all junctions past the Mermaid Holiday Cottage, (formally Mermaid Public House) and past the view point to a black sign marked:-

Alternative route HGV's [12.0 miles]

Left and continue along 'Morridge' to the:-

Junction with B5053 [16.1 miles] Signed Warslow 6 miles,

SHARP left along the B5053 to:-

Finish [20.6 miles] At a field gate just before Warslow Village Hall.

Notes Take care on the descents on the B5053 before and after Onecote.

Warnings:

Care at road junctions: Riders must exercise caution at all junctions. <u>Any competitor who's</u> riding line causes her/him to cross the central white line into a lane for on-coming traffic, when approaching or leaving a junction, may be disqualified from the event, and will be reported to the District Committee for potential further disciplinary action.

A competitor who swings out to the right before executing a left turn should ensure that the road behind is clear of traffic before doing so. The practice is not encouraged by the District Committee and competitors who ride in this manner are warned that in many circumstances this maneuver will be regarded as a contravention of regulation 47(i), (iii), (v).

Riders must not perform U turns in the vicinity of the start or finish of the event. Riders observed performing U turns will be reported to the District Committee who will consider disciplinary proceedings.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY,

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets.

It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

Doping Control

This event may be subject to a Doping Control.

It is your responsibility to check.

As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for Doping Control.

Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ at the sign on / sign out table.

If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby.

Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply
