There is limited parking at the HQ but there is a new car park available next to the start area (BA10 0EH) There is also parking available on the road up to Bruton train station immediately past the course start. Numbers will be available at the race HQ where you must sign on for the event, and can be exchanged for a drink on your return, **after you have signed off.**

Course details:

The course is the U303 starting and finishing in Bruton. The start is on the B3081 (Wincanton road) at a point level with the entrance to an industrial estate (O/S grid reference 686 347). Riders have priority at traffic calming point under the railway bridge immediately after the start. Proceed on B3081 to Stoney Stoke (2.5 miles – marshalled) and turn left, through Charlton Musgrove to give way junction at Leigh Common (5.1 miles - marshalled). Turn left on to old A303 (now part of the B3081) but **CAUTION: Traffic from right.** Continue through Bourton and Zeals to give way junction with B3092 (red warning flag and marshalled). **CAUTION: Fast downhill to junction and fast moving traffic from right.** Turn left towards Frome passing the turning to Stourhead and turn left to Kilminster Common (marshalled). **CAUTION: Short stretch of narrow road about 400 yards after turn.** Proceed across Kilminster Common to Yarnfield Gate (13 miles - marshalled) and turn sharp left. **CAUTION: Rough road surface on turn and pot holes for the next 300 – 400 mts.** Continue down hill, **CAUTION: Steep with bridleways off to right and equestrian facilities on left so take care.** Continue through North Brewham (30 mph zone and rough surfaces), under a railway bridge to finish by double gates to electricity substation approximately 200 yards short of A359 in Bruton. At the finish please call out your number to the timekeeper but do not stop to speak to the timekeeper. After the finish turn left onto A359. The Race HQ is just on the left.

Risk Assessment:

Please read the current risk assessment and safety notes, which will be available to riders at the Race HQ.

Other Notes:

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise competitors to wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard and fit a working rear light visible to following road users.

All riders under the age of 18 must wear a hard shell helmet conforming to a recognised safety standard (Regulation 15).

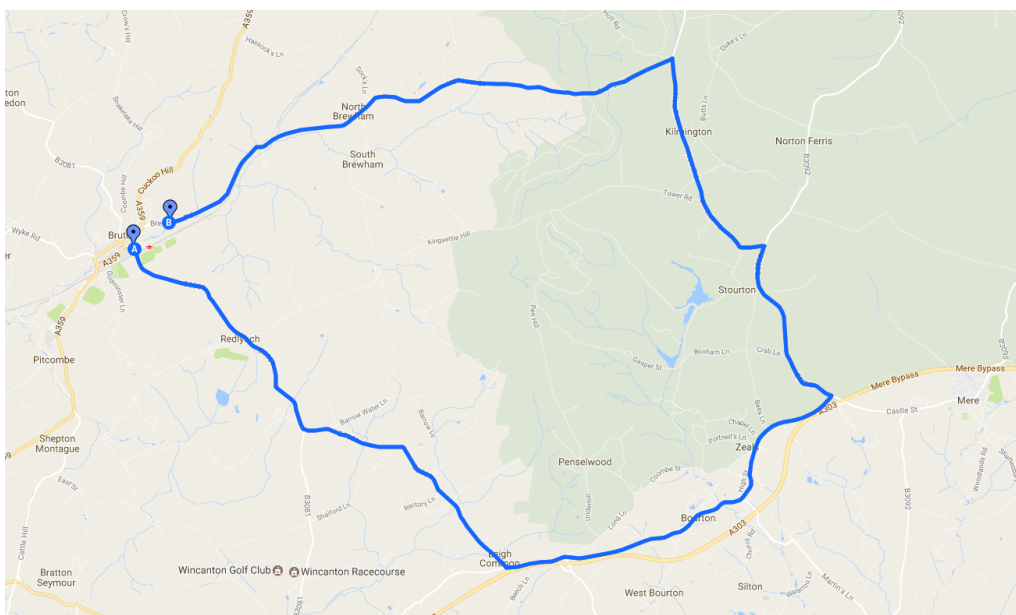
Spectators and competitors must not park at either the start or finish areas or interfere with the duties of the timekeepers. Please be respectful to other road users and residents during the event and when parking. Competitors must sign on and collect their number from the Race HQ and allow enough time to cycle from the Race HQ to the start (under 0.5 miles). **Riders must sign off after returning to their numbers to race HQ.** Please do not warm up on the course. U turns in the vicinity of the start or finish may result in disqualification. There is a good warm up circuit (0.75 miles) which avoids the course using the loop round Bruton (heading towards the start follow signs for Shepton instead of Wincanton, then follow signs for Frome & Shepton Mallet and up the High Street. This will take you back to the bottom of Quaperlake Street between the Race HQ and the start.
