The Course Q10/22

Start in Dickley Lane, Harrietsham at 18th kerb joint east of Marley entrance nearest to A.20 (TQ886528). Join A.20 and proceed eastwards to **turn** at Charing RAB. Retrace on A.20 to **finish** adjacent to Harrietsham Caravan Sales after Harrietsham railway bridge at 11th kerb joints west of lamp post KAMB27. (TQ870526)

Headquarters

The HQ is Harrietsham Village Hall, Harrison Drive, Church Road, Harrietsham ME17 1AP.

Church Road is on the left as you pass through Harrietsham on the A20 travelling towards Ashford and just before the railway bridge. Harrison Drive is 0.2 of a mile along Church Road on the right. The hall will be open from 6.45am for signing on. Parking is available at the Hall.

NOTES FOR RIDERS

Numbers will be in the event headquarters hall and will be personally issued to each rider after they have signed on. Riders should refer to Regulation 16 on page 342 of the 2017 National Handbook- which states that *'the number should be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear when in the normal riding position'*. Please note that for 2017 all competitors are now required personally to sign the signing out sheet when returning their number.

Failure to do will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF.

Numbers can be exchanged for a drink on completion of their ride.

Please keep noise to a minimum to avoid unnecessary disturbance of local residents.

Please remove racing shoes before entering the hall.

No rider should use a turbo trainer or rollers in the HQ parking area or adjacent roads and you will be asked to stop using them if found doing so. Failure to comply rider risks disqualification from the event.

Do Not perform U turns in the start and finishing areas and do not use these areas as a public toilet as offenders risk disqualification.

Strictly **NO PARKING** for riders or supporters in Dickley Lane or Marley's private car park near the start or at the finish except for timekeepers.

Riders should not arrive at the start more than 5 minutes before their allotted start time and must not turn or congregate in the driveway to the Marley works.

Riders proven to be associated with any car parking or turning in this vicinity will be disqualified from the event

Rider Feedback Forms - Riders should note that these forms are available at the hall by the signing on desk, and can be used by riders/marshals with comments and suggestions that could significantly improve safety.

All Junior/Juvenile riders MUST wear recognised standard protective headgear. In the interests of safety it is recommended that **all riders** should wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

It is also recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to your machine in a position visible to following road users & is active whilst the machine is in use.

Whilst competing riders must ensure they adhere to the Highway Regulations and CTT Rules and Regulations as disciplinary action may result from any breaches of these regulations. Riders must also ensure their helpers comply with the Regulations relating to vehicles.
