## **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

### **PARKING**

Parking at the HQ (Broom Village Hall) is extremely limited; however, additional parking is available at Jacana Produce – located down the High Street at B50 4HN. A marshal will be in attendance to help guide spectators and riders to suitable parking places.

Any person found to have parked their vehicle on the High Street outside the Village Hall will be told to move their vehicle and **may even be disqualified from the event** altogether.

Please note - Any complaints made by local residents about competitors parking on the High Street could greatly affect the use of the Village Hall as an HQ. Please respect the residents and park responsibly.

### **HEADQUARTERS**

Competitors will be able to collect their numbers from the HQ when signing on. A **free drink** is on offer for all competitors that return their numbers. Additional refreshments will be available for a donation. **Please do not wear cycling shoes inside the HQ.**

### **COURSE**

START: On B4048 (Redditch to Evesham Road) South of Dunnington crossroads at gully grating to south side of lane on left and opposite signpost to Dunnington village. Ride southwards (B4088)

At Norton island junction take first exit (3.6 Miles)

At entrance to Salford Priors village – Traffic calming barrier

At Salford Priors island junction with A46 take first exit – A46 (6.9 Miles)

At South Alcester Island (Little Chef) take first exit – A435

FINISH: Before River Arrow at first gully grating to surfaced driveway on left by 5-barred gate with notice “ATCL fishing – Private” (10 Miles)

### **COMPETITORS CLOTHING**

Competitors must be clothed from neck to at least mid-thigh. Sleeves shall be at least mid-upper arm length. (NO SLEEVELESS TOPS).

No competitor may carry advertising or the name of a commercial business on his/her race clothing except where he/she is a member of a club or team that has paid the advertising fee.

COMPETITORS MUST NOT COMPETE IN CLOTHING OF A TRADE TEAM that is/has been registered with the UCI unless they are a member of that team.

## **PRIZES**

Competitor times will be made available at the HQ.

One prize per rider (with the exception of the team prize) will be allocated at this event.

The team prize will be awarded to the fastest three riders from one club.

A prize presentation will be made at the HQ shortly after the last competitor has completed the course; so please try to stay for the presentation.
