We were blessed with near perfect conditions for this year's Finsbury Park CC Open 25. The conditions were very mild with a slight northerly which increased gradually throughout the event which helped riders on the hard leg out to the turn. Despite the fact we were on what some people believe to be the slower of the F1 25 courses the race ended with some 8 people returning Personal Bests.

This year's winner was George Fox (Wellingborough Cycles RT) who returned a great time of 50:15. Second place rider Leigh Smith (Equipe Velo) was 2 mins 56 secs behind with 53:11, while William Wallace (CC London) was a further 35 seconds behind with 53:46, both these riders returned Personal Bests. In the Womens standing Kate Gannon (Verulam CC) crossed the line in 1:07:05.

In the Vets standards Roger Sewell (Hounslow & District Whs) took first place with a +14:49 with Andrew Grant (Cambridge CC) 26 seconds behind on standard. Fastest team of three riders was Equipe Velo consisting of Leigh Smith, Richard Golding and Tom Krause. The Team time was 2:48:44. Congratulations to all the winners and those who recorded a personal best. Above all however on behalf of the Finsbury Park CC we would like to thank all of you for taking part and for helping make the event a success. We hope to see you again next year.
