Numbers and signing on:

Headquarters: The headquarters is Hatfield Woodhouse Village Hall, which is situated on the A614 in the middle of the village and will be signed on the day. Nearest postcode DN7 6PE. Parking, numbers and signing on at the HQ.

*** **You are free to race on a road bike.** If you wish to do this, simply turn up with your road bike and tick the box on the start sheet. You will then have your results collated within a separate road bike section. The only rules for this section are no tri-bars, no time trial helmets and no disc wheels.....and you can leave the rest of us to race as normal with silly hats etc ***

Prize list

Main prize list (one main prize per rider not including the team prize):

- Overall (Men): 1st - £25, 2nd - £15, 3rd - £10

Course description (O10/1)

- Start on A614 at Lamp Post No. 08209 near metal gate at southern end of Hatfield Woodhouse.
- Proceed southwards on A614 to Blaxton TI (5.026 miles).
- Encircle island and retrace along A614 to finish at LP No. 08212 at northern corner of triangle at end of Ancient Lane (10 miles)

Note the following (requiring extra care):

- Blaxton TI is small and oval (it’s an ‘oblongabout’!)

Please note:

- Keep your head up at all times
- At the START riders MUST NOT stand in the roadway.
- After finishing riders should not stop but continue to event HQ.
- No U turns WHATSOEVER within sight of the start or finish.
- No warming up on the course after the event has started.
- No Parking by anyone connected with the event on Ancient Lane

In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the Event Promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. Standard hard shell hats must be worn by juniors and under 18s.

We also advise, even in strong sunlight, the use of a rear light, set to steady flashing mode, to bring drivers’ attention to your presence.
