Only the fastest riders will complete the full course.

Riders will be moved onto the next section of the race at the discretion of the course controller. This will depend upon the speed at which the fastest riders complete each section. This will be at approximately 10pm (section 4), 6am (section 5) and 10am (towards finishing circuit). Pay attention to the marshals at all times.

All distances are given in miles and decimal parts thereof.

Bold text indicates a mileage reference point.

Start in the car park of the event HQ at the gully grating marked with a yellow line. Proceed the few yards to the highway (Oak Road) where Left and continue as follows.

On the finishing circuit

Once a riders 24 hours has elapsed they should keep riding until they reach either TK1 TK2 or TK3. Final mileage will be extrapolated based on the speed between the TK passed before your time elapsed and the TK after time elapsed.

RIDERS INSTRUCTIONS

- * Any incidents should be reported immediately to the organiser Jon Williams (07753612619) or David Williams (07757720921)

- * At traffic lights riders must obey the highway code and STOP if the light is red
 - * Riders without adequate lighting will be disqualified.

- * Cycling Time Trials (CTT) Strongly advise you to wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. All junior competitors MUST wear protective hard shell helmets

- * It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to road users and is active whilst the machine is in use
 - * Pedal reflectors must be used at night to conform to the highway code

- * Riders who decide to abandon the event must let the officials know as soon as possible. You must sign off.

- * Support vehicles must be registered, forms will be available from the signing on steward.

- * Course controller may direct riders to omit or repeat certain parts of the course, support teams should find out from the marshals if their rider is to be detoured.

- * Please take extra care on the Quina Brook circuit when joining the A49.
 - * Riders must ensure their race numbers are visible at all times. Please also call your number out for the marshals during the night time period.

FEEDING ARRANGEMENTS

* Night clothing, lights and other supplies may be handed to the signing on steward at the start of the event. Items must be clearly marked with your name and race number, when required, these can be collected from Prees island during the main circuits. They will be moved to outside the HQ during the finishing circuit.

* There will also be a feed station on the Tern Hill to Espley leg during the night time section of the event. They will have water and hot drinks and are happy to help during the hardest hours of the race.

DOPING CONTROL.

Remember all riders must sign off when they finish or retire from the race. Signing sheets will be at the HQ from commencement of the finishing circuit or Prees RAB during the rest of the event

This event **may** be subject to a Doping Control. As soon as you have finished you should return to the event HQ as it is **your responsibility** to check if you are required for Doping Control.

Race numbers required for Doping Control will be displayed at the HQ. If your number is displayed you should report immediately to Doping Control which will be nearby.

Remember, it is up to you to check and ensure that you comply.

If required you must report to Doping Control as soon as possible after finishing.
