Course Details : **H25/8 : A31 Bentley-Farnham-Holybourne**

796442 Start at a point in the lead out onto the A31, from the lay-by on the South side at the start of the Bentley by-pass, approximately 800 yards West of the Bull Public House on the North side of the A31, 10 yards short of the last road drain at the lay-by Exit (Western end)
(Start).....0.000

736403 Join the A31 (**Care**) and proceed along the Bentley by-pass through Froyle and Neatham to the Holybourne roundabout,
(Turn)4.704

828459 Circle the roundabout ((**M1, M2, M3**) (**Check**) and take the **Third Exit back onto the A31** to retrace, going through Froyle and along the Bentley by-pass to continue past the Bull PH to the Farnham Roundabout at the junction with the A325
(Turn).....11.907

736403 Circle the Roundabout (**M4, M5, M6**) (**Check**) and take the **Fourth Exit back onto the A31** To retrace past the start point (**14.294 miles**) to go along the Bentley by-pass to the Holybourne Roundabout
(Turn).....18.998

813448 Circle the roundabout (**M1, M2, M3**) (**Check**) and take the **Third exit back onto the A31** to retrace, going through Froyle and along the Bentley by-pass to continue past the Bull PH (**24.405 miles**) to a point **70 yards beyond the County boundary line and 23 yards** Beyond the start of a tarmac path on the North side where

Getting to the Start (Allow 15 minutes riding time):
Road surface is very poor between the village and the A31 slip road, take great care.

1. From the hall: Turn left at the cross-roads through Bentley Village and follow this road which runs parallel with the A31.
2. Proceed until joining the A31 via a slip road. Watch out for earlier competitors coming up from behind you, who could be travelling at 40+ m.p.h.
3. Follow the A31 down the hill, East for approximately ½ a mile to the junction (minor X-Roads) just before the now closed Bull PH.
4. Turn (GREAT CARE) across the dual carriageway, retracing along the A31 for approximately ¼ mile up the hill to the first lay-by (**Start Point**);
5. On finishing continue to the next break in the carriageway. Turn (GREAT CARE) and proceed along the A31 past the start point (CARE) and leave the A31 at the next slip road (signpost Bentley);
6. Turn right at the 'T' junction and continue over the A31 to return to Bentley Memorial Hall.

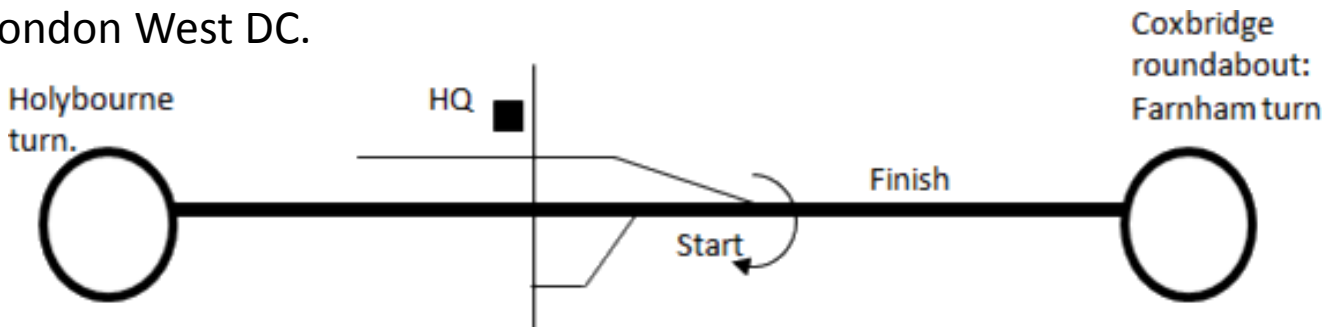

LOCAL REGULATIONS applicable to the H25/8 course.

- **Shoulder numbers** must be prominently displayed on the **LEFT ARM**.
- **Any rider seen crossing the central reservation**, before ,during or after the event, except at one of the specific breaks in the reservation made for that purpose may be disqualified and will reported to the London West DC.

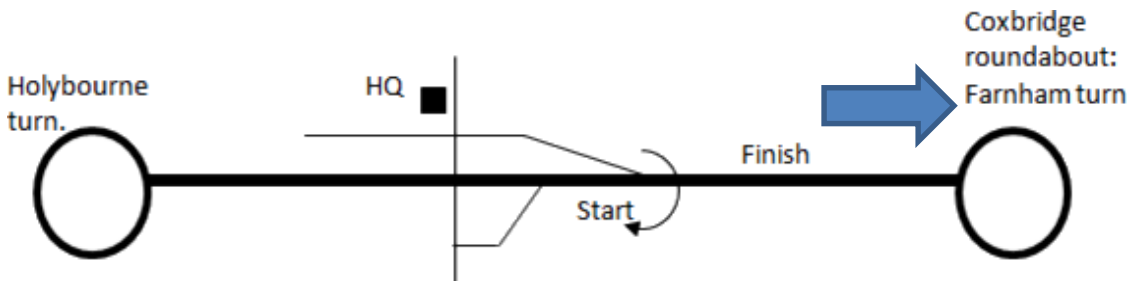


- **Any rider seen steering using their Tribars**, when entering, navigating and exiting any part of the Coxbridge (Farnham) roundabout may be disqualified, and will be reported to the London West DC.
- **In the interests of your safety** you must use the **widest part** of your handlebars.
- Cycling Time Trials Limited and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a **HARD SHELL HELMET** that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.
- It is also recommended that a working rear light, either flashing, or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

Safety Notice.



There is a deep trench on the minor road leading from the HQ to the start area as you approach the main A31 carriageway (Eastbound) take great care.

The (A31) road surface **approaching** Coxbridge roundabout **from the West** is in a very poor state of repair. A rider fell here in an event in May 2016, with no other vehicles involved. Take extra care, and under no circumstances attempt to enter the roundabout whilst steering with your triathlon bars. You must use the widest part of your handlebar. This is a D.C. Regulation.



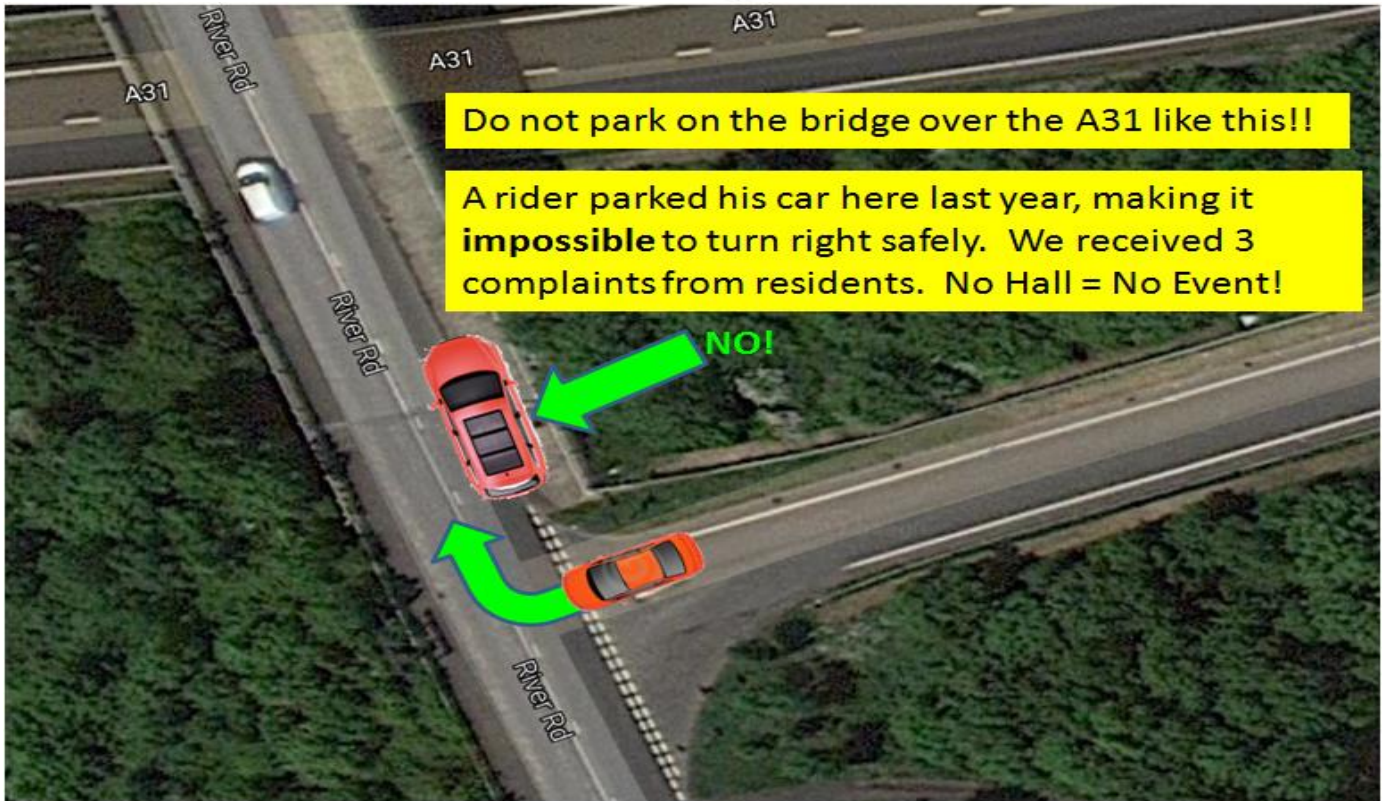

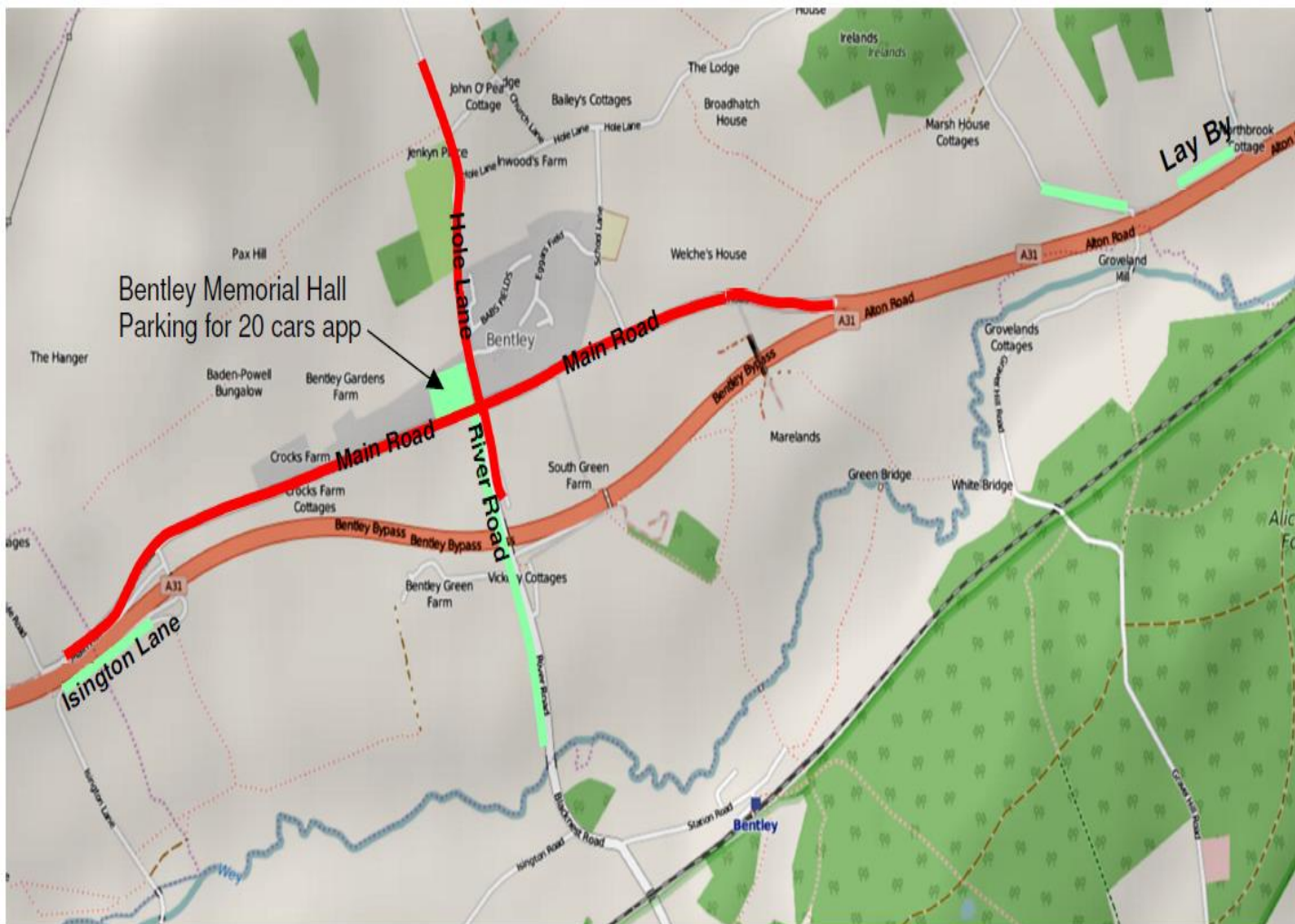
