Event Headquarters:

Glossop Leisure Centre, High street East, Glossop, SK13 8QA.

Limited parking is available at the HQ – Direct access from the car park to signing on room can be gained through side entrance. Please do not park in front of or block access to any neighbouring properties. Additionally, please do not use any turbo trainer or roller devices in close proximity to residential properties. No parking at the start under any circumstances.

Headquarters will be open from 08:30hrs. Numbers need to be collected from the HQ, where the results board as well as a range of refreshments will also be available.

Please return your number after your ride.

Course:

The start is approximately <1.0 mile from headquarters.

Turn right out of HQ and proceed along High Street East (A57). At the roundabout, proceed straight across and continue along High Street East which later become Sheffield Road (A57). From the roundabout continue for a further 0.6 miles where you find the Royal Oak Pub and the start line on your left.

Record holders.

Men - Tejvan Pettinger (Sri Chinmoy Cycling Team) 11 minutes 36.6 seconds. Sunday 1st September 2013.
Women – Joanne Blakeley (Champion System/Maxgear/Base) 15 minutes 21.6 seconds. Sunday 31st August

Start: On the A57 at the 1st grid east of the Royal Oak Public House proceeding along the A57 towards Sheffield.

Finish 3.2 miles On the A57 where the Trans-Pennine Trail crosses the road at the summit.

Note to competitors

- Competitors prior to starting are not permitted to ride past the finish timekeeper during the duration of the event.
- Any competitor making a 'U' turn in the vicinity of the start or finish will be disqualified from the event.
- Warming up on the course is not permitted during the duration of the event.
- No parking on car park or frontage of Royal Oak Public House
- Riders must keep to the left hand side of the road except when overtaking. Failure to comply with the above may lead to disqualification.

In addition to the above

- Riders **MUST** give their number either at the finish or at HQ.
- Riders **MUST NOT STAND** in the road at the start or finish. (This constitutes obstruction and is a breach of Regulations)
- Riders **MUST NOT** ride with their heads down.
- All competitors under the age of 18 and/or juniors **MUST WEAR** a HELMET of HARD SHELL construction.

Competitors Machine – Lights

CTT recommends that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY

Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets.

It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
