Brenzett Village Hall, King Street (TR001271) TN29 9UW Please allow 15 minutes to get to the start. The hall will be open from 6.30am. No racing shoes in the hall and **please keep noise to a minimum.**

Course Details Q25/12 Old Romney – Brookland – Kingsnorth 2 – Old Romney

Start at western end of layby on A259 near to Oasis Diner (TR 033251). Riders should start in the layby at the point opposite the apex of the grass island separating the layby and the A259. Riders should join the A259 and proceed to Brenzett RAB (M) junction of A259/A2070 /B2080 left to Brookland RAB (M). Turn and proceed via Brenzett RAB (4.71 miles). Take 2nd exit onto A2070 passing straight through Bridgefield RAB (M) to Cloverleaf RAB (13.68 miles). Take 2nd exit to join A2042 to turn at Kingsnorth 2 RAB (14.2 miles) rejoining A2042 and fork left within 300 yards to Cloverleaf RAB. Take 1st exit onto A2070 passing straight through Bridgefield RAB (M) to Brenzett RAB (23.93 miles) where left on to A259 to finish approximately 25 yards west of access road adjacent to Prospect Bungalow (25 miles) (TR 018260)

No competitor parking for vehicles at start or finish

- Please do not warm up on the course after the event has started. The performing of U-turns within the start and finish areas is strictly forbidden. Offenders may face disqualification, if seen carrying out this dangerous manoeuvre.
- Numbers will be in the event HQ Hall and will be personally issued to each rider after they have signed on.

- Numbers can be exchanged for a drink upon completion of the ride.
- Please be aware of vehicles entering and exiting the Boot Fair between Brenzett RAB and Brooklands RAB
- Promoted for and on behalf of Cycling Time Trials under their rules and regulations. Riders who use an inhaler for medical reasons (asthma etc.) should register the fact with British Cycling to satisfy UCI, CTT and BC anti-doping regulations.
- No rider should use a turbo trainer or rollers in the headquarters parking area or on adjacent roads. Anyone failing to comply with this restriction risks disqualification.

This is in response to complaints received from local residents.

- In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoter strongly advise you to wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.
- It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to your machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
- Riders should refer to Regulation 16 which states that *“the number shall be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear when in the normal riding position”*.
- Rider Feedback Forms are available at the hall by the signing on desk and can be used by riders or marshals for comments and suggestions that could improve rider safety.
- Whilst competing riders must ensure they adhere to the Highway Regulations and CTT Rules and Regulations, disciplinary action may result from any breaches in these regulations.
