General Information

Event HQ

Fairwarp Village Hall, Nursery Lane TN22 3BD – Open from 6:00am. Heading north on the A22, turn right at Lampool Roundabout into Straight Half Mile Road. Turn left onto B2026 Lampool Road then second right into Nursery Lane. The HQ is on the left.

Car Parking

There is limited parking in the car park, when full please park sensibly on the hall side of the lane with consideration for other road users and local residents. **Please do not block horsebox access for the property at the top of Nursery Lane.**

Race Numbers

Race Numbers will be available at the event HQ. Please collect your number when you sign on. **If pinning your number please only use the eyelets, and please do not use additional pins as it tears the numbers.**

Additional Hazards

Notice of any additional hazards to be aware of on the course will be displayed next to the signing on sheet.

Start

The start is less than a mile from the hall. Proceed out of the car park and turn right, at the give way turn left, proceed to the next give way, turn right and at Lampool Roundabout take first exit to the start.

Signing Out

Please note that all competitors are now required personally to sign the signing out sheet when returning their number. In accordance with CTT regulations, failure to do so will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF.

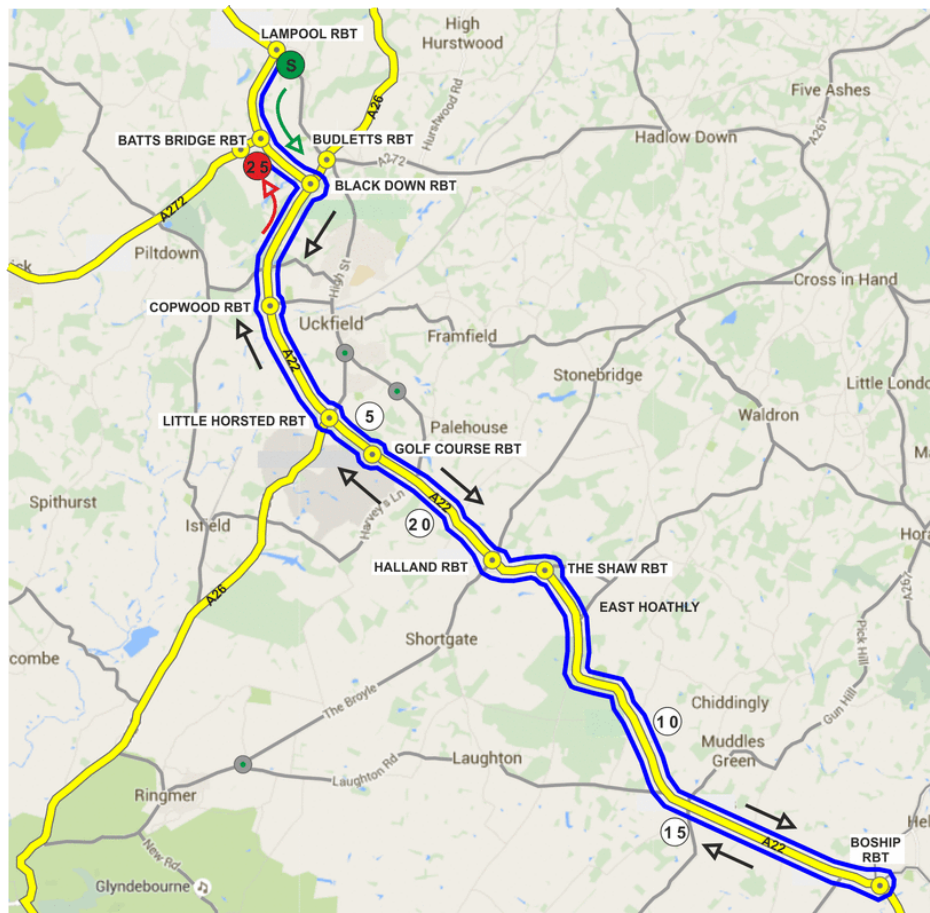

TQ511165	Proceed to Batts Bridge RBT. Straight on 2nd exit to Black Down RBT. RIGHT 2nd exit following Uckfield by-pass via Copwood RBT to Little Horsted RBT. Straight on 2nd exit via Golf Course and Halland RBTs to The Shaw RBT	07.52m
TQ572172	RIGHT 2nd exit and continue on A22 via Whitesmith and Golden Cross to Boship RBT where TURN (Check)	13.08m
TQ511165	4th exit to retrace though Golden Cross and Whitesmith to The Shaw RBT	18.63m
TQ468231	LEFT 1st exit and continue on A22 via Halland and Golf Course RBTs to Little Horsted RBT. Straight on 2nd exit and follow A22 via Copwood RBT to Black Down RBT	24.40m
TQ461236	LEFT 1st exit and follow Maresfield by-pass to FINISH at red arrow on curb opposite drain in lay-by before Batts Bridge RBT	25.00m

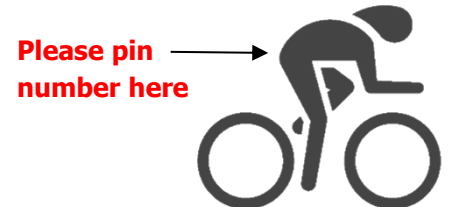

Please pay attention to the following CTT regulations/recommendations

- **Helmets** CTT regulations require the compulsory use of helmets for the under 18s. In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise all competitors to wear a hard/soft shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.
- **Parental Consent Forms** All riders under 18 download a parental consent when they enter online. The form must be completed and brought with you on the day. Please hand it in before signing on.
- **Lights** It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.
- **Warming up** Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the first rider has started.
- **Competitors' Vehicles** No vehicles, except those of timekeepers and event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish.
- **Official Observers** Official observers will be stationed around the course.
- **Results** No times will be given out at the finish.
- **Race Numbers** The race number is made of fluorescent material which is an important safety feature. It is essential that it is placed correctly for maximum visibility to other road users and of course the timekeepers. No time may be recorded if number is not correctly positioned.
- **Signing Out** Please note that for 2017 all competitors are now required personally to sign the signing out sheet when returning their number. Failure to do so will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF.



This is a qualifying event for

ESCA Points Competition 30 points for 1st place down to 1 point for 30th place for riders from an ESCA affiliated club. The individual points earned by each rider are totalled and awarded to their respective club.

ESCA Trophies Counts towards the fastest junior, fastest lady, fastest rider under 60 minutes, highest veteran plus on standard and the fastest team of three from an ESCA affiliated club over 25 miles – the best performance at either this, or the **April 25**, will be eligible for these awards at the annual prize presentation in January 2018.

ESCA BAR Qualifying event for all the Best All Rounder competitions.

Brian Phillips Trophy Donated by East Grinstead CC in memory of their teammate Brian Phillips who tragically died during the 8-up team time trial event in Viareggio in March 2011 – the trophy will be awarded at the annual prize presentation in January 2018 to the overall winner of the open event.
