HQ, signing-on and numbers

In The Swan hotel which is between Streatley and Goring (by the river on the Streatley side). The hotel is undergoing renovation so please ride/drive around to the rear of the hotel (follow diversion sign which takes you past the church), and I'll set up the numbers on one of the tables in the bar area.

Please use the paddock for parking and the portaloos in the carpark for changing etc. By coincidence, Greenbox StreetFood traders will be serving food in the garden after the event, so in addition to the sandwiches, cakes and coffee available in the bar, you will be able to purchase vegan burgers and wraps in the garden whilst recovering from your hill climbing efforts (even skinny hill climbers have to eat).

The hotel management have agreed that bikes can be brought onto the lawn at the front of the bar, or onto the island, accessed over the small footbridge (all at the back of the hotel next to the river). Bikes are left unattended at owner's risk (it's a safe area, but best to keep an eye on it, lock it, or put it away in a car just in case).

The venue makes a great change from your usual village hall, so please be respectful and aware of other guests who may not be cyclists.

Results board and tea/coffee

The results board will be situated in the same place as the signing-on sheet at the back of the Swan Hotel. A free coffee/tea will be provided to each rider upon handing in your number at the bar.

Prizes will be presented shortly after the second stage, by our well-known local bike mechanic, Ricci, of Pankhurst Cycles. Ricci was very recently voted runner-up in the best UK bike mechanic competition (think Bake-Off head to head and you'll be on the right lines). So please do stay.

Notes

Promoted for and on behalf of Cycling Time Trials under their rules and regulations. Take extreme care on the course as it is an open road.

Please note that a competitor:

- (a) may be held up but shall not receive a push start
- (b) may not cover any part of the course on foot
- (c) must not be accompanied by persons on foot.

1st stage: Goring Hill

How to reach the first climb

Turn left out of The Swan hotel, continue along the road for approximately ½ mile, crossing the railway bridge, to reach a T-junction. Turn right and after 100 yards turn left. The start is a short way up on the left-hand side.

Course details

Start in Goring-on-Thames at the corner of Sloan Close and B4526, Reading Road, about 50 yards east of the junction with the B4009. Climb up the hill on B4526 heading towards Crays Pond (care on sharp bends near bottom of climb, max gradient 1 in 10), to finish opposite Flint House after 1.7 miles.

After the first 'kick' of the hill, the remainder drags all the way to the finish, so an excellent roadman's climb.

2nd stage: Streatley Hill

How to reach the second climb

Turn right out of The Swan hotel, continue along the road for approximately ½ mile until you reach the crossroads. Continue straight on, past The Bull public house on your left until you reach The Coombe road about 400m up on the left-hand side.

The race begins at the corner of Coombe Road and continues for approximately 1km to finish outside a house's gravel drive on the left-hand side of the road just over the crest of the hill.

The climb starts off at a 1 in 10 gradient and increases to around 1 in 6. In my opinion it is by far the toughest climb in the area, so gear accordingly else you might not make it to the top!!
