PARKING

- No Parking at the Start or Finish other than Timekeeper Vehicles.
- There is adequate parking available at the HQ.

H/Q

- Open from 9:30.
- No Cycling Cleats/Shoes inside.
- Competitors must sign-on and sign off using the sheet provided.

YOUR SAFETY

- **'U' turns at the start or finish will lead to disqualification.**
- **Care at Road Junctions**
Riders must exercise care at all junctions. Any competitor whose riding line causes him/her to cross the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.
- In the interests of your own safety Cycling Time Trials & event promoters advise you to wear a **HARD-SHELL HELMET** that meets international accepted standards.
- In accordance with Regulation 15 **ALL JUNIOR** competitors must wear protective hard-shell helmets.
- It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.

CHELFORD ISLAND

Riders must negotiate Chelford Island in a safe and sensible manner in accordance with CTT Reg. 20 and the rules of the road. Riders must be able to brake and stop at the island if traffic conditions require this. Riders **MUST NOT USE** their tri-bars between the first bollard they pass on entering Chelford Island and the last bollard they pass leaving it. ***Remember - traffic on the island has priority over traffic (including riders) entering it. Any rider seen to be in breach of this regulation will be disqualified from the event and may be reported for further disciplinary action.***

DIRECTIONS TO START

On leaving Siddington Village Hall, turn right onto the A34 and follow the road for 1.9 Miles until you reach the A537 (Monk's Heath). At the traffic lights, turn left onto the A537 and head west for 0.4 Miles going beyond the next set of traffic lights to the start line at the layby.

The start is roughly 2.3 miles from the HQ, so please allow at least 15 minutes to get to the start line.

COURSE J2/1

START: On the A537 in the centre of the lay-by, approximately 500 yards west of the A34 at Monks Heath, heading West. **(0 Miles)**

CHELFORD ISLAND Take 3rd Exit onto the A537 to Knutsford. **(1.2 Miles)**

BOOTHS HALL ISLAND Take 4th Exit/U Turn back onto A537 to Macclesfield **(5.2 Miles)**

CHELFORD ISLAND: Take 2nd Exit onto the A537 to Macclesfield **(9.4 Miles)**

FINISH: Adjacent to the second stud back from the end of the first lay-by after Chelford Island **(10 Miles)**

DIRECTIONS FROM FINISH

Continue straight along the A537 for 1.2 miles until you reach the traffic lights at Monk's Heath. Turn right onto the A34 following the road for 1.9 Miles and turn left back to the HQ.

No times will be given at the finish; please do not obstruct or distract the timekeeper.

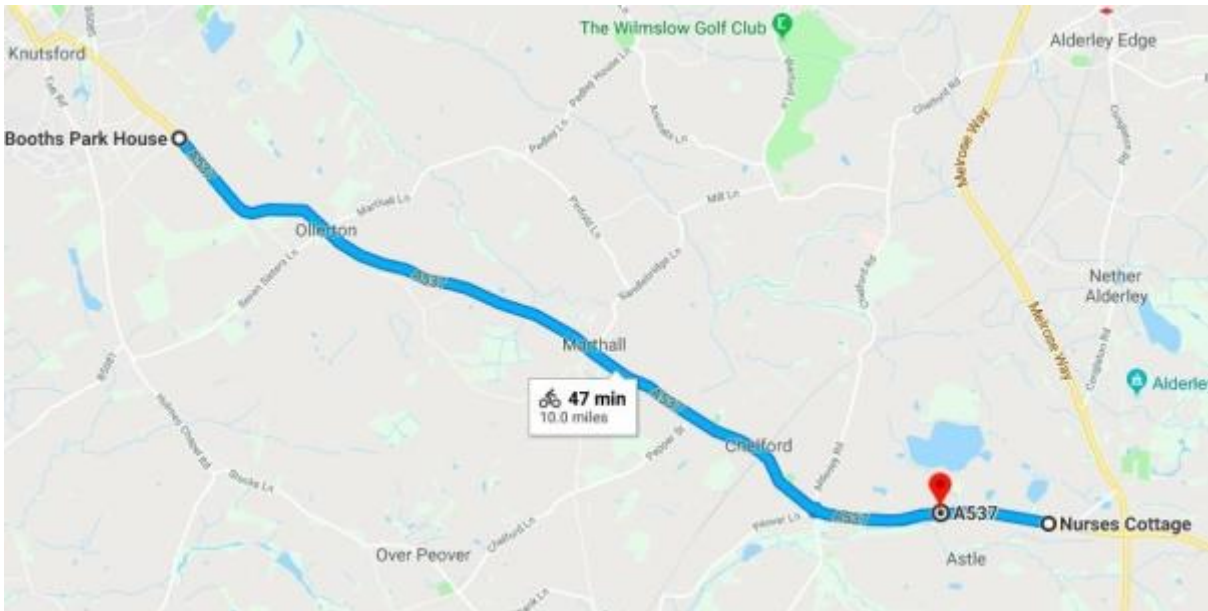
