After his third consecutive attempt, congratulations go to **James Hayward** (Woolwich CC) for claiming the title of 2016 Wigmore CC Hill Climb Champion and also the KCA Hill Climb Champion at Hollingbourne Hill. James got tantalisingly close to the magic 3 minute mark with a time of 3mins 4.0 seconds, making it the fastest ride since 2006. Only 2 other riders have ever gone faster with the course at the current distance – both in 2006 – one of whom was **Bill Bell** (Bigfoot CC) who this year came home second with a time of 3:16.1. Third place went to Neil Lauder (4T+ Velo Club) in a time of 3:17.5.

In the ladies contest, **Debbie Percival** (34 Nomads CC) took the title with a time of 4:29.9. This was Debbie's 11th consecutive year in the Wigmore hill climb which is unprecedented among all the riders, so a big thank you to Debbie for continuing to support the event. Coming home second was **Megan Panton** (Woolwich CC) with 4:41.1 – even more impressive when considering that Megan is still only 15 years old. Third place and by only 1.6 seconds went to **Jacintha Hamilton-Love** (Dulwich Paragon CC) in 4:42.1.

Tim Woodlock at **The Bike Warehouse** once again sponsored the event with prizes for various categories. The 3 minute and 4 minute ladies records prizes of £200 each remained safe for another year but the youth prizes were all snapped up, and with deserving results. In the junior category, the Wigmore CC made it a one-two with **Robin Jarvis** taking the honours in a time of 4:15.8 and **Ewan Muir** following closely behind in 4:24.4. With both riders still only 16 years old and first year junior riders, they have got a couple more years in the age category – keep up the good work lads! In the juveniles, **Theo Tadros** (InGear Quickvit Trainsharp RT) retained his title from 2015 with a time of 4:13.3. Theo's time was slightly down on his 2015 time but I think we can forgive him given he punctured on a warm-up ride on the hill and so ran back to the top, in cleats and carrying his bike in order to borrow his dad's front wheel. There were comparisons between Theo and Chris Froome on Mont Ventoux in this year's Tour de France but these were quickly dispelled when someone pointed out that at least Theo actually carried his bike with him. Our second fastest juvenile this year was **Cameron Kemp** (Quick Release CC) in a time of 4:22.2. Well done to all our youth riders, not just the prize winners. We had 11 youth riders in our event this year which is fantastic and we all look forward to seeing how these riders develop their times in the future.

To the other end of the age categories and the veterans, where we kept the same age groups as last year. Retaining his title in the 40-44 age group was **Bill Bell**, with **Pete Tadros** (InGear Quickvit Trainsharp RT) similarly retaining his 45-49 title and **Keith Walker** (Wigmore CC) making it a trio by retaining the 50-59 age group. In the 60-69 bracket, **Trevor Benton** (West Kent RC) was also in the prize money.

To the team prize, and **Woolwich CC** won the title for the fastest 3 riders comprising **James Hayward**, **Alex Pearson** and **Kevin Armstrong** with a combined time of 10:29.0.

As always, the effort from the supporters behind the scenes was invaluable in order to make it a safe and issue-free event. The Boyd Family once again very kindly allowed us to use their farm at the top of Holingbourne Hill which provides us with a perfect headquarters for the race, allowing ample parking and plenty of space for the tea and cakes which this year were served by Laura Philbrook, Helen Grassby, Claire Pickering, Joyce Trice and Deanne Trice. In charge of traffic and rider management, both in the farm and at the top of the hill were Jason Nind, John Booty, Phil Appleby, Ben Foames, Clin Maisey, Adam Grassby and Ray Gunner. Taking care of things at the bottom of the hill were Roch Moppett, Geoff Martin and Mo Jury. Timekeeping was, as usual, taken care of by Vic Williams (Medway VC) and David Abbotts (Gravesend CC) with Richie McKenty recording and Harry Trice as recorder's assistant. Roy Mace was once again taking care of the numbers and parental consents at the signing on table. Lets also not forget our five charity collectors; Deana and Joe Collins, Hannah Grassby, Dylan Harman and Ruby Pickering – along with Steve Harmann for keeping control of programme and sticker stocks – who distributed event programmes while collecting for the Kent, Surry & Sussex Air Ambulance. The proceeds are still to be counted but on behalf of the Air Ambulance I would like to say a big thank you to everyone for their generosity of this very worthwhile cause.

Finally, congratulations go to **Franco Della Mura** (Wigmore CC) and his partner and now fiancée Vinnette Powell. Franco proposed on the hill and thankfully Vinnette accepted. Congratulations and best wishes to you both for the future.
