Thank you for entering this event. It is run each year as a memorial to Fred Peachey, my father.

Fred joined the “Gentlemen of the De Laune” in 1952 and worked tirelessly for the Club and our sport in general, until his sudden death in February 1969. Fred served on the De Laune committee undertaking various posts as well as representing the club on the then RTTC London South committee, the BCF South East division, the RRA, the Southern RRA and the SCCU. Fred also found time to support all De Laune riders in every aspect of the sport – it didn't matter to him what type of cycling activity club members participated in, so long as it involved two (or three!) wheels. He promoted this open 25 for many years and, as a mark of respect and to honour his memory, club members provided the perpetual trophy that is on offer today to the fastest rider on scratch.

## Course Details

### Challock – Canterbury – Ashford – Chilham

Start on A.252 east of Molash at corner post of Northdown House at entrance to Shottenden Lane. (TR 032522). Proceed east on A.252 and A.28 to Milton Manor RAB Thanington (6.726 miles). (M) Turn and retrace on A.28 via Chilham fork where bear left (EXTREME CARE) (M) to Spearpoint Corner RAB (17.126 miles). (M) Retrace to Chilham fork where left (M) to rejoin A.252. Proceed westwards to finish approx 290 yards past Chilham Castle Keep entrance (TQ 063535).

No parking within sight of start and finish timekeepers. Anyone proven to be associated with any car parking or turning in the vicinity of the start will be disqualified from the event. Riders should allow 10 minutes to ride to the start.

For events starting in the morning no rider to use a turbo trainer or rollers in the HQ parking area or adjacent roads that are within 50 metres of a domestic property. Anyone failing to comply with this restriction risks disqualification.

Numbers will be available in the HQ from 630 am – please sign on before taking your number and remember to return to the hall to sign off before going home, failure to do so will result in you being classed as a DNF. Tea, coffee and cakes will be available at the HQ upon your return.

Please keep noise to a minimum around the hall – it is Sunday and the local residents may not want to be up as early as you. Remember to remove your cycling shoes before entering the hall.

Rider feedback forms will be available at the HQ by the signing on area. Marshals and riders are encouraged to submit their comments accordingly, with regard to improving the safety of the course. Please hand them to the promoter or any member of the De Laune CC at the event.

In the interests of your safety Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a hard shell helmet that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. In accordance with Regulations ALL riders under the age of 18 MUST wear a recognised protective hard shell helmet.

It is recommended that a working front and rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to your machine in a position visible to other road users, ensure that it is active whilst the machine is in use.

**Riders should be aware of Regulation 16 which states ‘the number should be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear when in the normal riding position’. A missed number by the timekeepers could result in a missed time for you.**

**Please remember to keep your head up at all times and enjoy your ride.**
