# EPILOGUE

A calm day without the threatened rain and a full field, with all reserves getting a ride. Nick Dwyer took Best on Standard for the men with 8.03 and riding time of 19.09 after fixing an insoluble mechanical problem!. Sue Rust was first woman with a plus of 7.43, 3rd overall on standard. The standards are working. Murray Kirton and David Stockley took first in the tandem event with a plus 5.47.

Improvised changing and HQ facilities did the job more or less adequately albeit not everyone found their way to the bar with the (free) cakes and drinks. Better than changing by the roadside as one rider commented!

A few of the later riders were delayed by traffic queuing at the Aylesbury turn. This was due to temporary traffic lights about 1/3 mile beyond the course. Although the traffic count at that point showed the overall level of traffic was well below the permitted level, some riders definitely had slower times as a result.

Thanks are due the large number of people who made this event possible: Peter Tasker, Phil Melville and John Payne at the start, no less than 5 members of the Hassall family at turn one, Brian Foran and Nikki Hunt and Richard Moule at turn two, Gordon Hart, Kevin Hallahan and John Hoskins at the finish, Alex Marzec posting results, Rachael Elliot for the flapjacks - which were all eaten before the "bought in" cakes, Stuart Stow for HQ preparation and reserve duties and Joy Payne for clearing away, John Hassall for collecting signs and John Lacey for being in reserve. It takes lot of people to run any event and some of them had to be at the road side for three hours concentrating hard. In the case of the time keepers much time is taken up after the event checking the results. One person who helped enormously although not there on the day was our President, Jim Burgin. He produces the "traditional" start sheet and results which are an important feature of LHC events. It was his 89th birthday on Sunday and he stayed at home with his family having a party and watching cricket!

Sorry to end on a negative note BUT, unfortunately, a few riders failed to come into the finishing slip road earlier enough and were disqualified. As must have been apparent from the warnings and large photos sent to every rider in the start sheet and on display at the HQ the rule is a safety measure to reduce the risk of riders being killed by fast moving vehicles entering the slip road on the riders' nearside. It is only two years since Ray Dare was killed, just a mile away so everyone must be aware of the consequences of a collision between a cyclist and a car travelling at 70 mph plus. No official likes disqualifying a rider but the rule is very important and will be enforced in all VTTA promotions on this course.
