PLEASE BE QUIET AT THE HALL IN THE MORNING

No rider to use a turbo trainer or rollers in the HQ parking area or adjacent roads that are within 50 metres of a domestic property. Anyone failing to comply with this restriction risks disqualification.

No Parking near the start except for timekeepers.

Riders should not arrive at the start any more than 5 minutes before their allotted start time.

CTT advise that you wear recognised protective headgear. CTT Regulations state that all juniors and juvenile riders must wear such headgear.

Riders who use an inhaler for medical reasons (Asthma etc.) should register the fact with BRITISH CYCLING, to satisfy UCI, CTT, and BC anti-doping regulations.

Numbers will be at HQ (and not the start) and may be exchanged for a drink after. Riders are required to sign on before collecting their number and also to sign back at the end of the event. Failure to sign back will result in a DNF on the results.

It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active when the machine is in use.

Whilst competing, riders must ensure they adhere to the Highway Regulations and CTT Rules and Regulations, disciplinary action may result from breaches to these regulations. Riders must also ensure that their helpers conform to the Regulations relating to vehicles.

It is a legal requirement (Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations 1989) to use appropriately fitted pedal reflectors and also a rear reflector (which may be incorporated into a rear light) as well as front and rear lights when riding in the dark (ie between sunset and sunrise). The onus is upon the rider to obey the law.

Riders will be expected to fit appropriate front and rear lights.

Please note that C.T.T. Regulation 16 states that the number shall be centrally positioned below the waist so as to be clearly visible from the rear when in his normal riding position. Position number as shown Please note that any rider whose number is not positioned correctly will not be allowed to start.

You must observe C.T.T. Regulation No 21.

Forms can be downloaded at https://www.cyclingtimetrials.org.uk/documents/index/riders or at the sign in table so that you can register your support vehicle. The K.C.A. Committee will disqualify any rider guilty of infringing C.T.T. Regulation No 22. Attention is drawn specifically to paragraph (c) which states:

Where vehicles are to be authorised a full description of the vehicle and registration number shall be given to the event promoter prior to the start of the competitor. A competitor shall not be overtaken by his support vehicle more frequently than once every 10 miles. Where possible the vehicle must be driven at normal traffic speed and must not follow the competitor, nor impede or annoy other competitors. Any competitor whose authorised vehicle impedes or causes annoyance to any other competitor shall be liable to disqualification from the event.

Where any other vehicle precedes or follows for any length of time, or frequently passes a competitor, that vehicle shall be deemed to be associated with that competitor who shall be liable to disqualification from the event.

Please read this and ensure that your driver understands the restrictions of this regulation.

Support Vehicles on the circuit should take extreme care to avoid obstructing riders as there are sections of the circuit that are very narrow. No individual helpers are to park or operate within 300 yards of any circuit timekeeper.

When you finish make sure your helpers do not obscure the Timekeeper's view or impede other riders. Please note that NO Riders or Vehicles are to stop at the Timekeepers, but they must continue to a safe and convenient stopping point.

Please ensure you are conversant with C.T.T. Regulation 25.

You should note that there will not be marshals at every junction, but it is intended to place arrows around the course. However, You are responsible for ensuring that you follow the course correctly. Take Extra CARE at the RIGHT TURNS.

To reach the start from the H.Q. turn left from Brenzett Village Hall toward the B2080 and take the third exit to join the B2080 to the Brenzett roundabout. Take the third exit A259 (signposted Hastings). The start is approximately 150 metres from the roundabout.

Riders should be aware that they risk disqualification for obstructing other riders at the start or on the finishing circuit or using these areas as a public toilet. Toilet facilities are available at the Event H.Q.

A result board will be at the event H.Q. which will show provisional distances. Do not bother the Timekeepers. Information regarding non finishers will be welcomed.

The K.C.A. wishes all competitors a safe and enjoyable ride.

FEEDING ARRANGEMENTS

There will be no feed during the event. Riders may hand in their own food and bottles, labelled with their name, and it will be taken to Brookland round-a-bout. Please make sure that you leave clearly marked containers at the vehicle with the Feeding Sign at the Event HQ.

MARSHALS

Indicate the direction to be followed in a positive manner but Do Not Hold Up the Traffic. Please wear a marshal's jacket. There will be jackets at the event H.Q. at Brenzett Village Hall. If you borrow a jacket please either hand it to your relief or return it to the hall. Please return marshal's check sheets to the Event Organizer or the Roving Marshal.

TIMEKEEPERS

Timekeepers should report to Brenzett Village Hall at 2.30 p.m. to synchronise watches and be allocated Time Keeper stations.

REFRESHMENTS

Light refreshments will be available at the hall from 5.30p.m. onwards.

MASSAGE

We are lucky that Jackie has brought her massage table to the 12 Hour for several years and she'll be there again this year. It's a popular feature of the event and we'd like to suggest that you donate a minimum of £5 to her to cover the cost of her oils, etc.

ADDITIONAL SAFETY NOTES FOR RIDERS

Level Crossings.

There are three level crossings on the course and finishing circuit, these may be monitored throughout the event, failure to obey the traffic signals could lead to riders being disqualified.

Brenzett Garage

When exiting the Brenzett roundabout onto the A259 be aware that motorist are likely to turn into the garage with late or no indication.

Would all riders please note:-

There are proposed road works at East Guldeford Level Crossing which may require an alteration to the early part of the course.
