IN THE INTERESTS OF YOUR OWN SAFETY, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

Riders under 18 years old MUST wear a hard shell helmet.

This rule will be strictly enforced. Competitors under 18 without a helmet WILL NOT be allowed to start.

A note on equipment:

Please note that if you are riding fixed you must have a **working brake on the front** and you must have a **lock ring on your rear sprocket**.

If you are riding a free wheeled machine you must have a working brake on **both** the front and rear wheel.

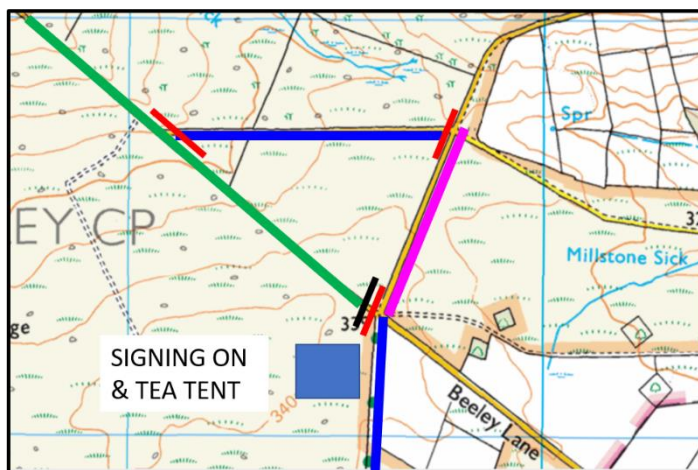
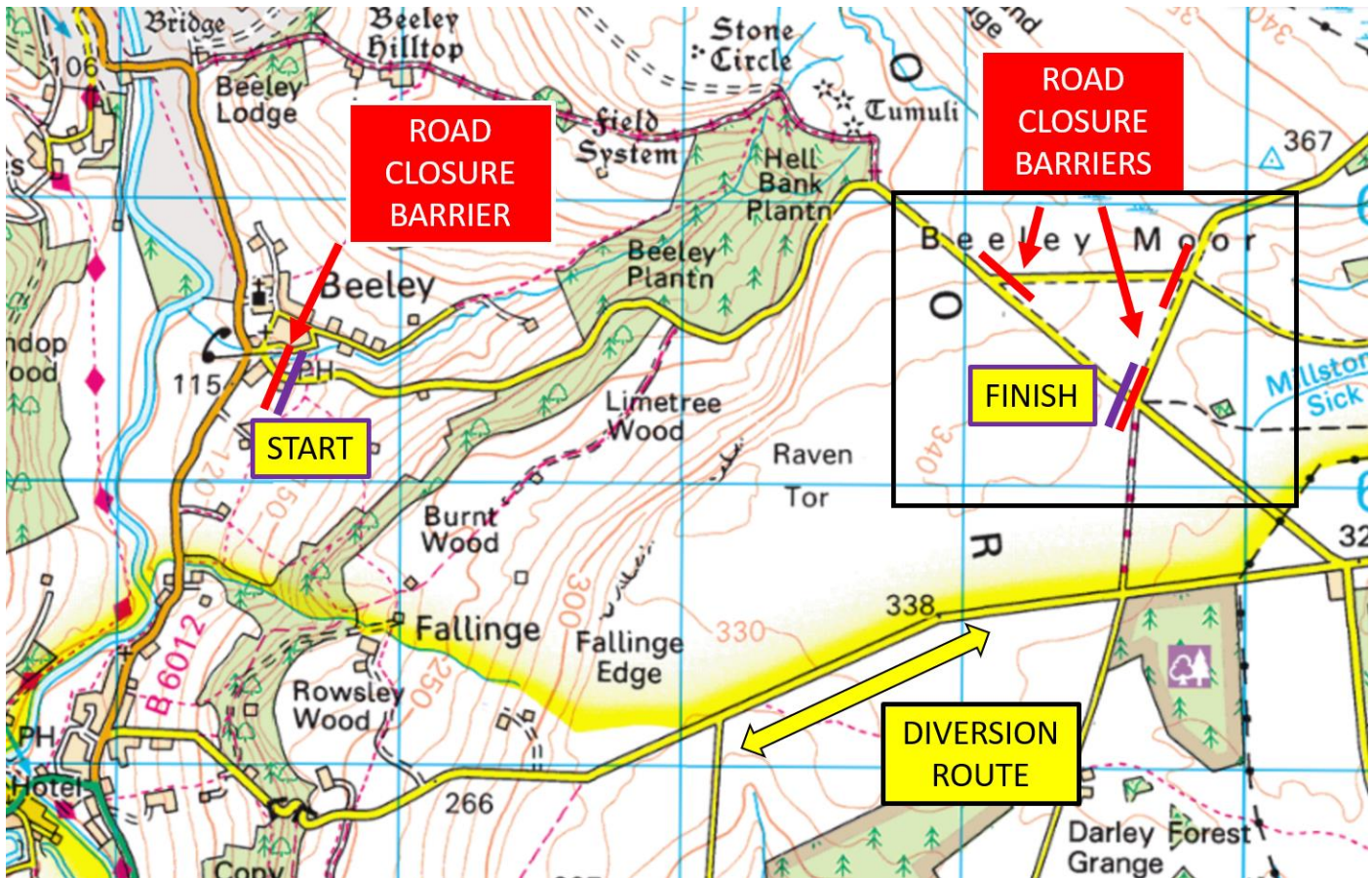

Course Details - OHC8 Beeley Moor. 2.3 Miles

Start in Beeley village at gateway (GR 267674) approx. 140 yards east of the Devonshire Arms PH. Proceed eastwards to finish at rough lay-by adjacent to crossroads on the brow of the hill. (GR 297670). **Headquarters** area is at the top of the climb on the unmade road. Refreshments will be available.

Signing on sheet and numbers will be at the headquarters near to the finish area.

AT THE FINISH:

Soon after crossing the finish line you will ride past the road closure barrier and continue along Beeley Lane. You will be on an open road so please ensure that you observe the rules of the road.

PLEASE NO PARKING at the bottom of the hill, in the carpark of the Devonshire Arms or along the top road as shown. Obtaining further road closures relies on the support of the local people and if we cause more disruption than necessary, we will not get another one. Thank you.

Road Closure schedule

10.30am	Road closed to the public and to all motorised vehicles other than those authorised by the event organisers. Competitors can warm up on the course. Stay on the left side of the road as you ride up and down the hill.
11.15am	Course closed for warming up. Riders descending after this time will not be allowed to ride back up the hill
11.20am	Event starts. Racing competitors can use the full width of the road. Riders descending to start MUST GIVE WAY to competitors coming up the hill. If in doubt STOP and let the ascending rider pass by.
2.00pm	Road reopens to the public.

Competitors arriving after the road closure:

I am aware that some of you will be cycling from Matlock having competed in the Riber hill climb. If you arrive before 11.15am you can ride straight up the hill but please be aware of competitors catching you up. Please pull over to one side and let them pass.

If you arrive after 11.15am you will be allowed to ride up the hill but only under the direction of the start marshal.

If you are driving to the event from the A6 you must follow the diversion up Rowsley Bar if arriving after 10.30am.

Competitors leaving the event whilst the road is still closed:

Some of you are riding Bank Road in the afternoon and therefore you will leave the event whilst the road closure is in force. Whether by car or bicycle, you must follow the diversion and return to the A6 via Rowsley Bar.

Thanks in advance to all of the helpers and the timekeepers and to Kate for the cakes.

Please **stick around for the prize presentation** which will happen as soon after the last rider has finished, or to put it another way; as soon as Guy and me have done the sums! If you are dashing off to race on Bank Road, and you miss the presentation, I will arrange to get your prize to you. This will either be in person or via BACS payment.

Every rider signing on will get a free cup of tea (mashed by Hazel) or coffee (for all you of a 'continental persuasion') on return of your number.

All money raised by the sale of refreshments will go to Ashgate Hospice.
