REFRESHMENTS

OB Café (all social distance rules apply). Old Buckenham Courty Park is home to the OB Café – this is cycling friendly café frequented by many local cyclists and cycling groups – at this moment I am not sure how late they will stay open – please support if possible, their coffee is first class.

Toilets are available on the site - please use sanitiser and treat respectfully and maintain social distancing.

B30/1B (Attleborough – Snetterton – Browick – Snetterton – Attleborough) Revised 2018

START at paint mark two metres before 'Clearway' sign on sliproad from B1077 to join A11 westbound at Attleborough . Proceed westbound onto A11 and proceed to cross Attleborough roundabout and proceed on A11 to exit onto sliproad signed 'Snetterton Circuit/Horse Welfare' (brown sign). Take sliproad to first roundabout where take first exit. At second roundabout take first exit and continue over A11 (bridge) to third roundabout where take first exit. At fourth roundabout take first exit to sliproad to join A11 eastbound.

Proceed eastbound, crossing Attleborough roundabout – passing all junctions – take sliproad to roundabout signed 'Mulbarton' (Browick Road). Take third exit across bridge to second roundabout where take second exit onto sliproad to rejoin A11 westbound. Retrace on A11 – passing all sliproads – over Attleborough roundabout and continue to Snetterton Circuit/Horse Welfare sliproad. Exit and retrace over bridge and roundabouts. Rejoin A11 eastbound, cross Attleborough roundabout to FINISH approx 1.25 mile from roundabout just after blue footbridge over A11.

HQ – Old Buckenham Country Park, Doe Lane, Old Buckenham NR17 1PP

Look out for CTT Arrows directing you to parking area.

Route to Start is approx. 4 miles

Directions to START – left from Country Park – Left at T Junction Continue on B1077 into Attleborough – At Junction (Caution) keep left and continue onto one way system – When safe to do so move to RH Lane and follow round (past Cranks Cycle Shop) Filter left at Garage and on B1077 towards Attleborough through first set of Traffic lights – then turn Left before A11 flyover – then Immediately left to start area..

Directions back to HQ from Finish – continue on A11 and exit at next slip sign posted WATTON/ATTLEBOROUGH B1077 – at Traffic light turn Right and head up hill into Attleborough at Junction filter onto one way system and continue past church, at Traffic light turn right and continue on B1077 through Old Buckenham – Turn right on Doe Lane to return to Country Park.

Numbers and signing on/out sheet will be Located near Carpark.

Please bring your own pen – and use provided sanitiser – After finishing please deposit your number in the provided bucket.

Attn. All competitors – Please note that for 2017 all competitors are now required to PERSONALLY to the sign out sheet when returning the number. Failure to do will result in the competitor being recorded as DNF.

CTT Regulations:

REAR LIGHTS

No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

Covering the Course

The onus of keeping to the course rests with each rider.

Awareness of Surroundings

Competitors must not use ANY audio equipment except prescribed hearing aids.

Where head and/or eye protection is used, competitors must ensure that this does not impair their vision or hearing.

N.B. A competitor in breach of this regulation shall be disqualified.

N.B. Competitors must not use a mobile phone while mounted on their machine.

EAST DISTRICT LOCAL REGULATIONS

U-TURNS will not be permitted on the course or roads adjacent to the START and FINISH whilst the event is in progress. Any breaking of this regulation in the first case may mean disqualification from the event. Further cases will be referred to the District Committee. A U-TURN is defined as a “180-degree turn completed within the width of the carriageway whilst astride the machine”. It is recommended that riders should dismount, check the road is clear in both directions, then with machine, and walk across the road.

The use of Turbos is prohibited for am starts. **WARMING UP - NO warming-up along the course once the event has started.**

In the interests of your own safety Cycling Time Trials strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an Internationally accepted safety standard. All competitors under the age of 18 and/or Juniors MUST wear a properly affixed helmet, which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078.
