

Corona Virus Protocol

No spectators are allowed on the course at any time. This is not a rule set by myself or the University of Bristol. This rule is set by CTT and can be found under their covid risk assessment on the CTT website. The only exceptions to this rule are the parents of young children (who I have already tried to contact) for safety reason and photographers. If you are a photographer who wants access to the course, please email me (tc14527@bristol.ac.uk). Please avoid bringing spectators where possible. This rule will be enforced with marshals at each end of the course.

People should not gather in groups of more than 6 at any time. People gathering in groups larger than six will be susceptible to getting a police issued Fine

People should aim to sign on 1 hour before respective start time. The purpose of this is to try and avoid a big wave of people in the village hall.

Masks (face coverings) should be worn at all times while in the village hall. If face masks cannot be worn for medical reasons let a Marshall know and they will cater.

People should bring their own pen to sign on. This is a ctt rule to avoid multiple people using the same pen.

Use common sense. Where possible try to keep as great distance as possible from other competitors and use common sense

No Prize Presentation. To avoid a congregation of people at the end there will be no prize presentation. Prizes will be mailed out the following week.
