Please find below the start sheet and information for the New Forest Round the Forest Open Time Trial.

PLEASE NOTE:

Unfortunately, there are major road works on the approach to Lymington that has necessitated a late course change for 2017. It has meant the start has had to be moved, and is now approx. 2.5miles from the HQ. The start is now on Silver street in Hordle, opposite the Three Bells pub:

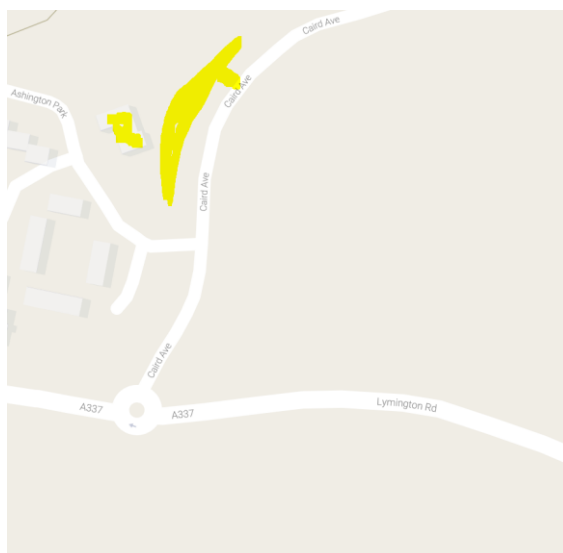

- Note that the start is now approx. 2.5 miles from the HQ so ensure you arrive in enough time to make your way to the start
- Take particular note of the updated risk assessment, in order to understand any hazards on the new start to the course this year.

P333 (2017 Revised) - Full Course Description:

START in Silver Street , new Milton, opposite the Premier Inn. Continue along Silver street (which becomes Sway Road) until the junction with the A337 (Southampton Road). Turn left then right at the roundabout immediately after into Marsh Lane. Continue along Marsh lane until the mini roundabout, continue straight (first exit) and then left at the second roundabout (first exit). Continue over level crossing and river bridge and bear left on B3054. Proceed to Hatchet Pond. At junction with B3055 (10.8m) give way and turn right to Beaulieu where continue straight on at B3054/B3056 junction. Proceed along B3056 to junction with A35 at Lyndhurst (19m). Turn left along High Street where turn left again - one-way traffic. Take right hand lane to Goose Green, go straight on then turn left again to rejoin A35 (20m). Continue along A35 to crossroads at the Cat and Fiddle pub (30.3m), where turn left through Walkford to RBT where left to FINISH beside Fawcetts Field on the A337 (32.3m)

Safety Notes:

Please obey the following:

- Riders must not make U-turns in the vicinity of the Start and Finish.
- Please note that observers may be in attendance along the course!

Take Extra Care of the following notes:

- Take note that the start is in a residential area. Given the early start, riders should be especially considerate of the surroundings and keep noise to a minimum and remain off the road.
- It is requested that riders arrive no earlier than 5 mins at the start in order to avoid clogging the road and pavement. If arriving please wait in the pub car park directly opposite the start.
- Note that the course crosses a level crossing and two cattle grids
- Beware of animals in the road between Lymington and Lyndhurst

Signing on and Race Numbers:

Riders must sign the official signing on sheet at the event HQ to obtain their race number For 2017 all riders MUST sign out in person when returning their number to HQ, anyone who does not will be DQ and will not receive a time/placing.
