### COURSE - M18

**Ponteland - Whalton - Belsay - Ponteland**

**Distance 18 miles**

**Date: Saturday 8th April 2017**

**First team off 2.02pm, and thereafter at 2 minute intervals**

### M18 - COURSE DETAILS

Start on minor Ponteland to Morpeth road alongside field gate approximately 200m south of the entrance to Northumbria Police HQ at Ponteland .  
Continue north to T-junction with B6524 and continue through Whalton to T-junction with the A696.  
Turn left on the A696 and continue through Belsay to Finish, opposite Dissington Lane End approximately 1/2 mile before Ponteland.

### NUMBERS AND RESULTS

All riders MUST sign the "**signing on sheet**" before collecting their number.  
All riders MUST sign the "**signing off sheet**" when handing numbers back in.  
Numbers and results shall be available at race **HQ - Merton Hall, Ponteland NE20 9PX**.  
Hall will be open from 1pm.

### PARKING

Parking is available at HQ. All vehicles or competitors, officials and marshalls are to be parked safely and without hindrance to other road users.

## **HELMET NOTE**

## **RTTC PRINCIPLES AND GUIDELINES**

All riders are responsible for their own safety.

You must obey the rules of the road and obey all traffic signs, signals and direction indicators.

It is your responsibility to ensure that your machine is roadworthy and that you ride safely at all times.

You must look ahead and not ride with your head down.

You must not take pace or shelter from any other vehicle or competitor (no drafting).

Failure to comply with the above may lead to Disciplinary Action being taken.

No warming up on the course once the event has started.

No dismounting by riders in finishing area.

No U-Turns to be made by riders in the vicinity of the timekeeper at the start.
