

## BARROW CENTRAL WHEELERS (NLTTA SPOCO)

Open 21 mile SPOCO Time Trial

Joanna Cebrat (360cycling) headed the Female riders with 57.00 finishing 19th overall



## **L212 Coast Road 21 course description**

Start opposite North Lodge cottage on the A5087 at the lamp post where grass and tarmac meet. Proceed south past Bardsea Bay (1.4 miles) through Baycliff (3.5 miles) to the roundabout at the junction of Rampside Road and Rampside village (8.1 miles). Take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit and proceed to the halfway point at Roose roundabout (10.5 miles). Take the 3<sup>rd</sup> major exit and retrace the outbound course. Finish on the A5087 exactly opposite the start point (21 miles).
