## **MESSAGE FROM THE EVENT SECRETARY GARY JACKSON**

This year has been more of a challenge than normal in many ways, both in respect of organisation and for riders. With no other events to hone fitness levels it has taken single-minded dedication to train alone, with no end to the lockdown in sight, so big congratulations to all riders still able to put in excellent efforts on a less than ideal day.

The organisation was no less tough. It was only two weeks before that the Government gave the ok for events such as ours to take place and riders then had one week before the closing date to decide whether to ride or not. To add to the problems, during that week Cambridgeshire Police declined our notification of the event. A big thank you must go to Nick Clarke and Nick Sharpe from CTT for their help and the new Covid Risk Assessment which, along with a lot of going through the Government guidelines and pointing out to the Police how we were allowed to put the event on and all the precautions we would be taking, we got acceptance from Cambridgeshire.

Finding time keepers who were available and not in self-isolation was also a challenge, but in the end, we had three of the best, who did a great job on the day, sitting in the rain, trying to keep their timing sheets dry!

With all the current limitations, getting the HQ was a challenge and much alteration and signage was required, but we must thank Mavis, the Caretaker of Westley Waterless Village Hall, for her help and for laying out the ropes and one way system at the hall, keeping you all safe and distanced.

Strangely, getting the marshals was easier than usual this year. Perhaps they were all itching to get out there and be involved in their sport in whatever way they could, but they all stepped up willingly, and carried out their duties on the day, in the rain, without complaint, and with a smile. They were, in order of contact with riders: Alan Clements and Geoff Fletcher at HQ, Richard Parrotte at the parking area in Six Mile Bottom, Jim Green at the start, Tim Stout, Brian Hurrell, Laurence Bellamy, Wayne Greve and Richard Austin at Four Went Ways, with Ian Jackson doing the number check.

At Red Lodge we had Norman Hurrell, also doing a number check, Mick Dodge, Ian O'Neill, Matt Steel, Phil Hodey and Nick McAuliffe, and at the bottom of the loop were Darren Lewis and Jim Poulain, also with a number check. Shortly after the roundabout was Keith West doing the 25-miles time split. And last but certainly not least was Derek Brandon, our No.1 marshal, doing a number check for the finish time keepers. Putting out all the road signs to and from HQ and all along the course was Paul Hirst. A big thank you to all of them.

Our time keepers were Laura Carter at the start and Frida Wezel and Michael Keen at the finish line. They did a great job, being at the start by 5.30 am to synchronise watches and collect start sheets, then being at the finish until the last rider at 9.58, then going through their sheets to make sure everyone got the right time. All in damp and chilly conditions. A big thank you to them as well.

But the biggest thank you of all must go to Keith West, without whom this event would surely not have taken place. From putting the event on the CTT website, to monitoring entries, working out, sadly, who to reject (we had 50% more entries than we could accept), creating the start sheet, then analysing all the finish times and double checking with the times recorded around the course by the number checkers to eliminate any possible errors, and to finally putting out the official times.

But this is not the end of his involvement. During the lead up to the event, we didn't know if we were to get permission from the Government to run the event, then when we did, would Cambridgeshire Police accept our notification or not? Finally, we got the ok, but we had a raft of things to do to be Covid 19 compliant. All through these trials Keith helped and guided me, putting in many late nights and early mornings, getting items needed for the HQ, like marker tape, hand sanitizer, disposable numbers, spare lights for riders, creating signs (many signs) and sending out numerous emails to riders keeping them informed of the restrictions we would be running under, and even the weather! We can't thank him enough for all his time and energy in this and, usually, many other events throughout the year.
