Credit where credit is due:

Congratulations and thanks to all of you that rode. It was a bit disappointing to see a much-reduced field compared to previous years, but that does seem to be how entries for TTs are going this year. Having said that – the lack of quantity was made up for in quality!

First mention goes to Jude Taylor who did a ‘Hayley Simmonds’ and set the fastest overall time of the evening on a road bike. Furthermore, he set an incredible new record, and in doing so posted the first ‘sub 42’ for a road bike. This is the second year in a row that Jude has set a new course record and it remains to be seen if he can make it a hat-trick next year. The financial directors at Peak RC are hoping that he won’t, to be honest!

In order for a record to be broken, it first of all has to be set, and after setting a juvenile record last year, newly minted junior rider Ryan Williams returned again to establish a record for the ‘junior male road bike’ category. Ryan went almost 1 minute faster than last year, and on this current trajectory he should be troubling the outright record by the time he is in his early 20s!

Tom Yiangou stormed to second place in the road bike event in, what was, his first ever hilly TT. This is a magnificent performance, but equally I’m sure his peers will hope that this will be his first and last hilly TT! On the subject of 2nd placings; Nick Latimer set a new PB, and Peak RC event record, with his first visit under 45 minutes. Clearly being an old man is suiting Nick!

Congratulations to Hayley Moore for surprising herself and winning the road bike category – “what, I’ve won a mug?!” and also to Rebecca Lineker for setting the fastest women’s time of the evening.

This year we only had one rider having a mishap – take a bow Elizabeth Bridgen – but I am pleased to report that the 2 riders who had difficulties last year had a trouble-free evening on this occasion. Sam ‘Bakewell’ Clark didn’t miss his start and, after a mechanical enforced DNF last year, I was pleased to see Richard Golding not only return, but also bag a prize. And yes Richard, I will fulfil the promise I made last year and refund your entry fee for coming back!

Finally, can I say well done for all of you for reading the start sheet and coming to the correct HQ. You all seemed to approve of the change of venue, and especially the drinks token, so we are planning to stick with the Eyre Arms as the race HQ for the foreseeable future.

I wish you continued success in 2022 and hope to see you again soon!
