Out of 59 entries there were 38 finishers, 6 DNF's, 15 DNS's.

It was a fine warm day, but the forecast gusty breeze from the west may have discouraged some from riding, and there were reports of tricky side gusts on the DC back from Mitchel Troy to Raglan.

Without any obvious reason, the number of riders DNFing because of punctures (all in the Men's event) was higher than normal. Though the road surface is in poor shape at Abergavenny roundabout, I didn't see any riders come to grief there. Elsewhere on this course road surfaces are generally in acceptable condition, so the cause remains unknown.

Although the wind strength and direction wasn't generally helpful, 11 riders still managed to improved their LTS.
