#### MESSAGE FROM THE EVENT SECRETARY GARY JACKSON

Having said "With a bit of luck we'll be back on the E2 next year" in last year's result sheet, here we were again on the F2 owing to the same road works on the A14! A big thanks to London North CTT District for allowing the use of their course, again.

The weather was just the same, again, perhaps even a touch hotter than last year. Good conditions for fast times with little southerly wind, if you could handle the heat. Unfortunately, several couldn't so we had sixteen non-finishers. The water left at the finish line proved welcome and should become a feature of the event if conditions are similar.

The usual HQ at for this course is Caldecote Village Hall, but by the time we knew we had to change courses this was already booked, so we had to use Toft, which was adequate, if a little short on toilet facilities and parking, but did have the benefit of a large drop down screen for the results and a comfy seating area for the refreshments.

Now on to all the people we need to thank for making the event run so smoothly:

First turn marshal and supplier of flags was Phil Hodey, then at Caxton Gibbet we had our marshal extrordinaire Alan Clements, newcomer Leah Brook, Richard Austin, and Paul Looke doing the checking.

At Madingley were Jonathan Whitwam, Andrew Wenham, Mark Fenwick and Jim Green with Ian Jackson doing checking. Finish time keeper assistant and results texter was Laurence Bellamy.

Making most welcome tea and supplier of cakes and biscuits was Brian Hurrell.

Once again the biggest thank you of all must go to Keith West, who did all the handicapping, emailing riders with start sheets, handled all the finish times and double checking with the times recorded around the course by the number checkers to eliminate any possible errors, and to finally putting out the official times.

Congratulations go to Tom Hutchinson for the fastest time of 1hr 37m 23s, a six second improvement, and to Kate Allan, fastest woman in 1hr 44m 28s, extraordinary in the heat. Also to Martin Fisher, 1st on Handicap with a massive 13m 36s improvement. Fastest Vet on standard was Angela Carpenter with + 46:08 but, as she was 2nd fastest woman, the award goes to Keith Ainsworth with his + 40:46. Not surprisingly, given they had the fastest and third fastest man (David Halliday) and fastest lady, the team prize went to Team Bottrill.

Who knows what will happen in the future? With courses on the A11 and A14 currently suspended and with roadworks everywhere we might be on the F2 again or on some new course. With different courses comes different regulations so Saturday afternoon or Sunday morning might be possible and we might choose a different date to avoid clashes, we'd like to get back to the days when the event was over-subscribed.
