COURSE DETAILS

S26R/10 – (2001) – Start on the old A30 at the lay-by approximately 200 yards East of Paterson's Cross, Feniton at a point 17 yards prior to the splayed end of the lay-by (GR 099978). Proceed Eastwards through Fenny Bridges and bear left under the bridges carrying the railway and the A30. Take the slip road up on to the A30. Remain on the A30 to pass the first slip road signposted Honiton. At the second slip road, signed "Luppitt, Canadian Cemetery, and Dorchester", filter left and over flyover. Immediately turn right (M) back onto the A30, signed "Exeter". Retrace outward route to filter left off the A30, signed "Ottery St.Mary", to give way (M) and turn left on to the old A30. Pass under the Railway Bridge and through Fenny bridges. Finish at a point 101 yards prior to the parapet of the old railway bridge and some 200 yards short of the start point (GR 102980.)

SAFETY

A hardshell helmet must be worn and working front and rear lights must be fitted to your machine in a suitable position to be clearly visible to following road users and active for this event.
No lights, no helmet - no ride.

Please observe the Highway Code at all times. Be prepared to give-way to traffic. Ride with your head up. Do not "white line". Wear bright clothing.

Event officials must not seek to regulate or interfere with other traffic. Riders waiting to start must do so 20m before the timekeeper and stand into the left in single file. CTT guidelines state that when a competitor is caught by another rider, the overtaken rider should fall back to a distance of at least 50 metres behind the overtaking rider.

On completion of the ride, riders must continue past the finish without stopping or turning in the road (do not stop by the time-keepers). Return to HQ by taking 1st R, 1st R again, and right at T to find the HQ on the R.

Please be aware of CTT Regulation 17(b) - From 2017 all competitors in open (Type A) events will be required to return to the event HQ, hand in their number(s) and SIGN OUT. A competitor MUST sign out him/herself. It is not permissible for another person to sign out on behalf of the competitor.

RIDERS PLEASE NOTE:

1) at approx half-way GIVE WAY right turn on fly-over.

2) on the return leg GIVE WAY left turn at the bottom of slip-road off the dual-carriageway. DO NOT cross the double white line when turning left— any rider doing so will be disqualified.
