Course Details:

Course Code: U7B

Start in middle of bus stop layby opposite start of the splay for the opposing layby (GR ST 69594 96432).

Proceed north on the A38 through Berkeley Road and over the railway bridges to the Slimbridge roundabout where turn (5.3 miles).

Circle and retrace south on the A38 to finish on opposite side of the road to a bus stop just south of Newport (GR ST 69836 97078) approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile before the start.

Important Information:

Parking spaces at the HQ are very limited and will mainly be occupied by race officials / volunteers. Please park in the local area whilst demonstrating a high level of respect for local homeowners. There are many lay-bys and lots of available parking around the start / finish areas. Please utilise these as much as possible. Where possible, please cycle to the HQ to collect & return numbers... think of it as extra training;)

If you do need to park in the housing estates around the HQ, please DO NOT lean bikes against other peoples property. There have been various complaints aimed towards cyclist by the locals over the years. It's important we respect the concerns of the local people to ensure the Stone Village Hall remains available to us (and other Clubs) in the future.

Please remember we are starting early (for some) and to keep noise around the HQ to a minimum.

All competitors **MUST** wear a properly affixed helmet, which must be of hard/soft shell construction. Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard such as SNELL B95, ANSI Z90.4, AUS/NZS 2063:96, DIN 33-954, CPSC or EN 1078.

All competitors - please be aware of CTT Regulation 14(i):

No competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to their machine a working white front & rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

NO FRONT AND REAR LIGHT - NO RIDE

U-turns:

U-turns will not be permitted on course or roads adjacent to Start and Finish areas while a race is in progress.

Note – Any breaking of this Regulation in the first case may mean disqualification from the event. Further cases will be referred to the District Committee.

Definition: A U-turn is defined as a 180-degree turn completed within the highway whilst astride the machine. (It is recommended that the rider(s) should dismount, check the road is clear in both directions, then, with machine, walk across the road).
