General Notes

CARE AT ROAD JUNCTIONS - Riders must exercise care at all junctions. Any competitor who's riding line causes him/her to cross the white line when approaching or leaving a junction will be liable to disqualification from the event and may be reported to the District Committee for further disciplinary action.

RIDERS PLEASE BE WARNED - that dangerous riding causes accidents and is endangering the future of this sport.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO ALL COMPETITORS

Please note CTT regulations requiring a **working front as well as rear light and the compulsory use of helmets for all competitors**: In accordance with Regulation 14(i) No competitor shall be permitted to start unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

In accordance with Regulation 14(j) No competitor shall be permitted to start unless such competitor has affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that is illuminated and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users in accordance with Regulation 15 - All competitors must wear a properly affixed helmet which must be of hard/soft shell construction.

Helmets should conform to a recognised Standard. There will be a separate start line official checking compliance with the regulations. Any competitor not in compliance will not be allowed to start.

AT NO TIME SHOULD RIDERS PERFORM U-TURNS IN THE ROAD – Local District Regulations prohibit U turns in the vicinity of the Start and Finish and any rider observed infringing this rule will be disqualified.

PLEASE KEEP YOUR HEAD UP AT ALL TIMES – riding head down is dangerous and causes accidents.

OBSERVERS ARE BEING USED DURING THIS EVENT.

There are road surface hazards along the Barton Road section, these are negotiable with heads up riding. Particular note that the middle roundabout at Llan-y-pwll has severe surface deterioration.

Please take care, particularly on the out leg with the left turn.

Directions to Start

Approx. 1.5 miles. From Barton Road turn Left onto Sibbersfield Lane then Left onto A534 heading towards Barton/Broxton/Carden Park.

Once on the A534 you may encounter riders finishing their ride. Please be courteous **and ensure** you ride in single file.

Proceed to past the finish on your left and start on the right, continue to the service station in order to make a safe turn around back to the start.

No U-turns on the A534 please – riders may be disqualified for practicing U-turns anywhere on the A534.

Course D10/25

Start on A534 opposite grid in lay-by (marked in white paint) ³/₄ mile from junction with B5130.

Proceed on A534 in the direction of Wrexham to 1st Traffic Island just past Waterways Garden Centre. 4.62miles. Turn Left at 1st exit towards Wrexham Industrial Estate.

Encircle next Traffic Island 5.10mls. Retrace to 1st Traffic Island.

5.91 miles bear Right on to A534. Proceed back down the A534 to

Finish at 1st Telegraph Pole No 7 (marked in White paint) in Lay-by on left approx. ¹/₂ mile past junction with B5130. 10.00miles



Road Bike Category Rules

For those who entered as road bike category - The CTT road bike category has a consistent and simple set of rules nationwide:

- The road bike can possess drop or straight handlebars
- No tri-bars, clip-on bars or Spinacci bars are allowed
- No disc wheels Both front & rear wheels must have at least 12 spokes each
- The maximum rim depth allowed is 90mm
