**Event headquarters: Boynton Village Hall, Boynton Bridlington YO16 4XJ**

**If approaching the HQ from the west, along the B1253 towards Bridlington, turn right at the crossroads in the village, towards the bottom of the steep hill. Please only park on the village hall side of the crossroads. We will aim to open the hall from approx 12.45 to 1pm, once the signs are up.**

Changing rooms, toilets and result board at the Hall, plus refreshments, hot and cold drinks.

Signing is at the H.Q. You must sign on before receiving your number and sign off having ridden the event. A copy of the course risk assessment and the risk assessment on the day of the event will be on display at the signing on desk.

Parking at the hall is along the road outside the hall. Please park considerately and not on the north side of the crossroads. We presently have a good relationship with the local residents do not put this in jeopardy by parking on the verge/grass or by sitting on the private bench, opposite the village hall. Thanks.

In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. This is compulsory for riders aged under 18 years and for juniors. It is mandatory to have working rear and front lights, either flashing or constant, fitted to the machine, in a position visible to other road users.

### **Course Description V461**

The course starts at telegraph pole 1, on an unclassified road, in Boynton village. Proceed north on unclassified road to Grindale, turn left (with care) and proceed west through Burton Fleming, Wold Newton to Foxholes. Turn left onto B1249 (Scarborough Road) proceed to Octon roundabout (10 miles), turn left onto B1253, continue through Rudston to Boynton and finish before the top of the hill, west of Boynton village, at the junction with minor road to Binsdale Farm.
