

Course details: Q10/44

Start in the service road at post box number TN27 300 0.16 mile west of Hart Hill, TQ 937 505. Proceed eastwards along A.20 to Charing RAB, taking the 3rd exit to continue along the A20 towards Ashford. Turn at Orchard Heights RAB TQ 997 441 (5.78 miles). Retrace A.20 to finish at traffic lights warning sign 0.43 mile west of Charing Crematorium entrance TQ 953 491 (10 miles)

COMPETITORS NOTES

1. Please note that following an amendment to Regulation 14 at the CTT National Council AGM in December 2021 it is now compulsory for each rider to have a working white front and red rear light, steady or flashing, on their machine when they start in all CTT events.

2. Following an amendment to Regulation 15 at the CTT National Council AGM in December 2021 it is now compulsory for ALL riders to wear recognised standard protective headgear that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

3. Failure to have a working front & rear light and to be wearing recognised standard protective headgear on the start line will result in you not being allowed to start the event.

4. Please do not use turbo trainers or rollers in the HQ car park and keep noise to a minimum due to being in a residential area.

5. Parking is not permitted at the start or at the finish.

6. The event HQ is 5 miles from the start, allow yourself at least 30 minutes to ride there. (unfortunately, alternative HQs were unavailable, and this is also due to the change in race distance)

7. It would be appreciated if riders do not wear shoe plates in the HQ.

8. Numbers should be centrally positioned below the waist to be clearly visible from the rear.

9. Riders who use an inhaler for medical reasons (asthma etc.) should register the fact with British Cycling to satisfy UCI, CTT and BC anti-doping regulations.

10. Whilst competing riders must ensure they adhere to the Highway Regulations and CTT Rules and Regulations, disciplinary action may result from any breaches in these regulations.

Remember: No lights or no helmet will mean no ride

Please note that Regulation 17(b) requires that a rider who fails to sign the official signing out sheet shall be recorded as DNF.

Please ensure you check to see if you are required for DOPING CONTROL.
