Parking: There is plenty of parking available in the Main Car Park at the front of the school. There will be ample space for riders to warm up on rollers/turbo trainers

No parking at the finish or on the road close to the start.

HQ to the start. (approx 5-6 mins)

- Turn right out of the main car park at the HQ.
- Straight over at the traffic lights immediately afterwards.
- After 200 metres fork left at the second set of traffic lights onto Stone Lane
- Down Stone Lane (care as it is a steep hill with a blind bend) to the traffic lights at the T junction
- Turn left at the traffic lights onto Cranborne Rd After approx ½ mile you will reach the start at the layby on the left hand side of the road (just before the Furzehill jct)

Warming up: No warming up along the course by competitors once the event has started.

Course: the event is held on the P427 course.

A map is available on the CTT website

- From the start proceed north along the Cranborne Rd to the Horton Inn pub (4.8m)
- Turn left onto the minor road to the junction with the A354 (9.2m).
- Turn left (CARE) onto A354 through Tarrant Hinton and Pimperne towards Blandford
- At Blandford Bypass rbt (14.7m) take the first exit left to the next rbt (15.6m).
- Then turn left onto the B3082 through Tarrant Keyneston towards the outskirts of Wimborne to finish approx 200 yards short of Queen Elizabeth School.

No U-turns in view of the start or the finish.

Start List

Lights: Just a reminder that CTT regs. require a functioning rear and front light. This is compulsory: no lights = no start. If you discover yours isn't working, ask Sign On (not the timekeeper) as the club has a small supply of spare lights. This is of importance given this is

an evening time trial: there are a number of shady parts to the course, which - especially on a gloomy evening - make lights essential.

Cycling helmets: CTT and the event promoter strongly advise you to wear a hard-shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.

Numbers: Will be at the HQ an hour before the first start. When you return your number and sign out you will get a free cuppa!

Toilets - changing and toilets will be available in the Leisure Centre at the rear of the school if required.
