Parking


There is very limited parking available at Race HQ, and the car park has a height restriction which will prevent access to any vehicles with bicycles on the roof.

Additional parking is available along the right-hand side of River Road/Station Road (heading south from Race HQ towards Bentley Station).

Please park on the grass verge and the bridge over the A31.
Do not obstruct the pavement or the bus stop.
Do not park on the left-hand side of River Road/Station Road
Do not park on Hole Lane (next to the hall) or on any of the residential roads in the village centre
Do not park in any place which restricts the sight lines at the crossroads in the village centre.

## Course

The time trial will be run on course $\mathbf{H} 50 / 8$, over a distance of 50 miles.
$\mathbf{2 x}$ Long Laps The course starts on the A31 at Bentley, and follows the road to the SW until the furthest turn point at the Chawton roundabout. Riders then ride back on the A31 in a NE direction, past the start point to turn again at the Coxbridge roundabout near Farnham, before riding SW back to the start line.

1 x Short Lap Riders repeat the long lap twice before completing a third, shorter, lap heading SW from the start before turning at the Alton roundabout (instead of the Chawton roundabout) and riding back to finish at Bentley.

It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure they are familiar with the route.

## Safety Notices

We are not aware of any planned roadworks on the course on the date of the event; however there are temporary traffic lights at Hole Lane in Bentley. Please allow extra time on your way to/from Race HQ.
Please take extra care when crossing the A31 dual carriageway when making your way from Race HQ to the start.

The road surface on the course is far from perfect, please be aware of the risk of potholes.
Please avoid the white hatched areas near slip roads especially if wet
Please do not pass other competitors on the inside

## Spectators

Spectators are welcome, however we have had complaints in the past of spectators shouting to cyclists from the bridges over the A31. Remember this is early on a Sunday morning, so please do not shout or cause annoyance to local residents.
