Course description: Start on A18 at N end of lay-by approx ½ mile N of Hatfield Green Tree PH (marked 25). Proceed to Tudworth TI (0.413 miles). Take 2nd exit on A18 to Crowle TI (6.678). Encircle TI (Give Way to traffic from left) and retrace on A18 to Tudworth TI (13.005). Left on A18 to Green Tree PH (13 995). Left onto A614 to Blaxton TI (20.102). Encircle island and retrace along A614 to finish just past first lamp post approx 100yds after Hatfield Woodhouse sign (25 miles)

Numbers will be available as usual at the event HQ prior to the event. Keep your heads up while riding and obey the rules of the road. Remember that marshals are not there to stop the traffic or advise you whether it is clear.





- Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise you to wear a HARD SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.
- In accordance with Regulation 15 ALL JUNIOR competitors must wear Protective Hard Shell Helmets.
- It is <u>MANDATORY</u> that a working front and rear light, rear either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position visible to following road users and is active whilst the machine is in use.
- No U Turns within sight of the start or finish. No warming up on the course once the event has started

The Village hall has kindly given us use of their facilities however please treat the other building users with courtesy. Children's dance classes often coincide with these events.

Catering facilities will provided. Feel free to bring cakes and tea/coffee will be provided.

There are temporary traffic lights currently in operation on the course and an alternative may be used. We are exploring options which would allow an approved 25 mile TT to be used in the event that the work (by Yorkshire Water) has not been competed.

This event may be subject to doping control

As soon as you have finished, you should return to the HQ as it is your responsibility to check if you are required for testing

Race numbers required for doping control will be displayed adjacent to the result board

Remember to sign off after you have finished
