NEW REGULATIONS which please read and take note:

CTT regulations require the use of a helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards for all competitors.

CTT regulations now require that no competitor shall be permitted to start either a Type A or Type B event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear light, and to the front of their machine a working front white light, either flashing or constant, that are illuminated and positioned to be clearly visible to other road users.


London South DC strongly recommend that riders do not wear black or dark clothing during any event held on the public road.

Under 18 years old riders: Bring a completed parental consent form to present before signing-on.

No form = no ride.

0.9 mile south of Rushfields/Poynings roundabout

NO parking is available. Some parking opposite in Devils Dyke Road, long lay-by, west side of road.

Numbers at HQ only. After the event please return your race number to the event HQ in exchange for a drink.

HQ to start: 2.0 miles ALLOW 15 minutes (includes final climb)

Route to start: LEFT out of the car park and continue UPHILL to the start area which is at the junction at the top.

Please remember to SIGN ON for your number and to SIGN OUT when you return it.

Please note the following CTT regulations and recommendations

Helmets: CTT regulations require the compulsory use of helmets for the under 18s. In the interests of your own safety, Cycling Time Trials and the event promoters strongly advise all competitors to wear a hard/soft shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.

Competitors' Machines: It is recommended that a working rear light, either flashing or constant, is fitted to the machine in a position clearly visible to following road users and is active while the machine is in use.

Competitors' Vehicles: No vehicles, except those of timekeepers and event officials, shall be parked in the vicinity of the start or finish (District regulation).

Safety Instructions:Details of any additional hazards not listed on the start sheet will be displayed at the signing on point. Competitors must exercise extra care when negotiating all roundabouts.

Warming Up: Competitors are requested not to warm up on the course after the event has started.

Observers: Official observers will be stationed around the course to ensure correct procedure (e.g. drafting and safety at roundabouts).

Results: No times will be given out at the finish line.

Race Numbers: The race number is made of fluorescent material which is an important safety feature. It is essential that it is placed correctly for maximum visibility to other road users and of course the timekeepers.

Body numbers should be fitted in accordance with Regulation 16 and Arm Numbers should be fitted to the upper arm with the number facing forwards (not inwards).

HERE

Be aware that "No time may be recorded if the number is incorrectly positioned".

Additional Safety Instructions

CARE - At bend at foot of first descent, where beware of crosswinds

CARE - The three corners in Fulking, 4 miles. Right, left and sharp right + obey 20 mph speed limit.


CARE - In Small Dole, pedestrian crossing lights must be obeyed.


CARE -The two mini-roundabouts where we go right......please slow down

At Henfield, DO NOT GO TO THE RIGHT OF THE ROUNDABOUT or you will be DISQUALIFIED

Apart from the Highway Code not sanctioning this unwise manoeuvre here, you simply cannot see whether there is any traffic approaching from your right. We'd like all competitors to return to base safe and sound

CARE - Be aware of horses; slow down, call out and pass wide please.
