COURSE DETAILS E2/10

START at paint mark at end of feeder road from West Wratting, just before junction with A1340 (1 kerb joint before drain near "Give Way" Sign). Bear left onto A1034 and proceed onto A11 southbound. Continue to take slip road to Four Went Ways intersection (A1307) (M), and circle Elevated Roundabout (5.14 miles) Take fourth exit on to A11 northbound (M). Retrace to Six Mile Bottom where take A1304 slip road (M), to FINISH at paint mark 5 yards past end of island between old road and slip road (at sixth kerb joint past plastic phone indicator post marked "85/0")

Riders are reminded that no competitor shall be allowed to start an event unless they are wearing a HARD SHELL SAFETY HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.

Riders are also reminded that no competitor shall be allowed to start an event unless such competitor has affixed to the rear of their machine a working rear red light and affixed to the front of their machine a working front white light; lights to be illuminated, either flashing or constant, and in a position that is clearly visible to other road users.

NO HELMET - NO LIGHT - NO RIDE

LONDON EAST LOCAL REGULATIONS

- 4.7 No Warming Up by competitors on the course once the event has started.
- 4.8.1 Marshals placed to direct competitors off the main carriageways must not stand at the apex between the carriageway and the slip road, but should be located at the beginning of the slip road.
- 4.8.2 No U-Turns are allowed within sight of either the start or finishing points. Riders carrying out this dangerous manoeuvre are liable to disqualification from the event and further disciplinary action by the District Committee.
- 4.8.5 Riders are reminded that dropping litter (such as energy gel wrappers) is a criminal offence and offenders will be liable to disciplinary action by the District Committee.

RIDERS' NOTES

The event has been handicapped using the Standardised Handicapping System modified for ECCA events. Please notify Organiser of any improvement in PB.

No parking at either the start or finish, other than timekeepers. Parking is available at and near the Event H.Q. and in the road to West Wratting. There must be NO parking on the grass verges either side of the entrance to the Veterinary Clinic and this area will be roped off. However, last year the Clinic kindly agreed to allow a field near the entrance to be used as an extra parking area. If this is available this year it will be well signed.

Body numbers will be available at the Event HQ and must be personally signed for after reading any special course instructions.

All competitors are reminded to personally sign the signing-out sheet when returning their number, otherwise they may be recorded as DNF.

Prize Presentation of Trophies and awards for the 2020 and 2021 Seasons

At the end of the race, the Prize Presentation will be held in the Village Hall and all riders are invited to stay and applaud the winners of the various trophies. In addition to the trophies there will be the medals won by individual riders. These will be sorted into collections for each club and riders are asked to take the medals and distribute to their fellow club members.

As the race includes the Presentation there will be free drink and cake for all riders and officials. If you wish to make a donation then these will be passed on to the Air Ambulance.

In order to obtain bigger fields, for 2022 the ECCA has decided to open its races to all, although with preference to ECCA riders. Judging by some of the entries from outside clubs the appeal of riding the superfast E2 course makes the long journey worthwhile. For those clubs that aren't affiliated and which are in our catchment area why not affiliate. Roadworks on the M11

For the last few weekends, from Friday night to Monday morning, the M11 has been closed from Junction 7 (Harlow) and Junction 8 (Bishop's Stortford) and it looks as though that will continue to at least 19th March. The diversion route through the outskirts of Harlow, then Sawbridgeworth and Bishop's Stortford, has many traffic lights and roundabouts, is usually busy and will have extra diverted traffic. Long delays will be likely. There is an alternative route to the east of the M11 but it is all narrow country roads and would require considerable local knowledge.

For those riders approaching via the M25 it would probably be worth taking the A10 northwards at Junction 25, via Cheshunt, Ware, Puckeridge, Buntingford to Royston where right onto the A505 and then via Duxford to join the A11 near Four Went Ways, Cambridge.

For riders from South Essex, then Chelmsford, Leaden Roding, Dunmow, Takeley and Bishop's Stortford would get you to Junction 8 of the M11. If you know the local roads there are slightly shorter routes.

So, check the Travel Update websites to see if the M11 is closed. If it is then start your journey earlier to allow for the extra distance travelled.
