Morning Event : Riber Road First man off 10.01

From Imperial Rooms turn left at the island and follow the A615 for about 500m to the cross roads after the Pelican crossing. Turn right and ascend to the start. Total distance about 1km.

COURSE, AHC/1: Riber Road

Start in the access lay-by to St. Giles Primary School, Starkholmes Road, Matlock. [GR SK301595]. Proceed up Starkholmes Road, fork left up Riber Road. Take the first right up the hill and then through the S-bend to finish 15m past the steep hill sign at the top of the hill.

Distance: 1.196Km. Course record, D Clarke 3-21.6

Gradients: 1st. 0.4Km 9%, next 0.15Km 0%, 0.64Km 14% (max 25%) and the final 0.01Km 0%

After finishing please continue to Riber village, turn right to Tansley then turn at the T junction in Tansley and follow the A615 to Matlock. This route will be indicated by ctt arrows. Please do not descend the Riber hill.

Riber Event HQ.

This year event HQ is Imperial Rooms. Imperial Road, Matlock DE4 3NL - the same as Bank Road HQ. Most of the adjacent car parking is "pay and display•. However single yellow lines do not operate on Sundays. Please be aware that traffic wardens are very active in Matlock at weekends so park sensibly. There is free car parking in Derbyshire County Council car park which is about 400m up Bank Road, just before the halfway mark for the Bank Road climb, on the left hand side.
