

Key Points

The Race

Please don't forget that both **FRONT and REAR lights are required,** you won't be able to ride the event without them.

If you're under 18 at the time of the event, it is your responsibility to provide a signed CTT parental consent form please ensure you bring it to HQ at sign on otherwise you won't be able to participate in the TT.

A copy of the CTT risk assessment for this course can be found below. If we find any further risks on the day, we will point these out as you sign-on at the event HQ

Baking and Tea/Coffee is provided by volunteers at the HQ, there is a nominal fee of £1, please remember to bring some change.

Please arrive at the HQ in good time to be able to sign on, pin on your number, warm up and head to the start .

No "U turns" or warming up near the start line as this can be dangerous and interfere with the TT

Road Bike "non-Aero" Category

"Road Bike Citeria: the road bike can possess drop or straight handlebars; no tri-bars, clipon bars or Spinaci bars are allowed; no disc wheels; both front & rear wheels must have at least 12 spokes each; the maximum rim depth allowed is 90mm. "

Please don't forget to return your number, it's important to sign-off after the event otherwise your result will not be valid!

AWARDS-We are hoping to have a short presentation at the end of the event, so please stick around especially if you are a Novice.

For the purpose of this event, a Novice rider must fall under the following categories: Either it is their first ever TT Event (the rider has never taken part in any A or B type events) or returning after a 4+-year break from both A and B type events, meaning their last race would have taken place before the pandemic).

Risk Assessment

Course/Road(s) Assessed: A1246/A63 Brotherton – Fairburn – Garforth (PeckField Bar). Date of Assessment/Review: 23/03/24

Course: V910 Brotherton - Garforth (Peckfield Bar)). 10 miles

Name of Assessor: Phil Hurt – Marjorie Boissinot

Course Description:

START on unclassified road leading from Brotherton village to A1246, at north side of gully grate, 10yds north of traffic sign for roundabout, on east side of road, and approx. 50 yds south of roundabout.

PROCEED NORTH to roundabout where 1st exit, left onto A1246.

CONTINUE northwards via Fairburn South (0.606 mls), Fairburn North (1.040 mls) and Selby Fork (junc. A63 - 2.208 mls) roundabouts to Micklefield (Boot & Shoe) roundabout (3.757 mls). TAKE 1= EXIT (left) and continue to Peckfield roundabout (junc. A656 - 5.244 mls).

ENCIRCLE ISLAND and RETRACE outward route via Micklefield (6.803 mis), Selby Fork (8.39 mis) and Fairburn North (Wagon & Horses – 9.584 mis) roundabouts to

FINISH at south end of Fairburn village, at northern edge of tarmac area leading to field, 50yds south of "speed limit ends" sign, approx. 75 yds before Fairburn South roundabout. (10.0 mls).

Traffic Flows: Where considered necessary, traffic counts undertaken at various times during events to ensure that events are not run during busy periods – time of start of event arranged to avoid periods of high traffic counts. A1246 has light traffic flow at all times of day, A63 section has light flows at times of events (evenings & weekends). Traffic counts not considered necessary.

Course/Event History:

Course on roads previously used for many events, at various distances. Mostly single carriageway road (3 miles of Dual carriageway). No problems encountered. Very infrequent local bus service (not Sunday or evenings). Some stops on course, but use bays at side of road.

New Regulations to apply to all events from 1st January 2022: (a) All machines must be fitted with working front and rear lights, either flashing or constant, which are in operation for the duration of the second
