RAB(3xM) (4.03 mls) by taking the 4th exit and retrace northwards on the A2070, passing Johnson's Corner

straight over Bridgefield RAB to Cloverleaf RAB (M) (13.07 mls). TURN at Cloverleaf RAB (M) by taking the

exit and retrace southwards on A2070, straight over Bridgefield RAB to Brenzett RAB (22.04mls). TURN at

Brenzett RAB(M) for the second time by taking the 4th exit and retrace northwards on the A2070. FINISH



COMPETITORS NOTES

- 1. Please note that following an amendment to Regulation 14 at the CTT National Council AGM in December 2021 it is now compulsory for each rider to have a working white front and red rear light, steady or flashing, on their machine when they start in all CTT events.
- 2. Following an amendment to Regulation 15 at the CTT National Council AGM in December 2021 it is now compulsory for ALL riders to wear recognised standard protective headgear that meets an internationally accepted safety standard.
- 3. Failure to have a working front & rear light and to be wearing recognised standard protective headgear on the start line will result in you not being allowed to start the event.
- 4. Riders should not warm-up on the course after the start.
- 5. It would be appreciated if riders do not wear shoe plates inside the HQ.
- 6. There will be a pusher off available to all competitors, but please politely decline should you not wish to be pushed off.
- 7. Numbers should be centrally positioned below the waist, so as to be clearly visible from the rear. If the timekeepers cannot see your number, you may not be given a time.
- 8. After finishing, you must return your number and 'sign out'. This is for your own safety and failure to sign out may result in disqualification
- 9. Do Not perform U turns in the start and finishing areas and do not use these areas as a public toilet. Offenders will be disqualified.
- 10. Riders must abide by all traffic signs, any rider found crossing the pedestrian crossing on the course whilst the red light is showing will be disqualified
- 11. Riding with hands and wrists draped over the front of handlebars risks disqualification in line with regulation 20.

Accidents

If a competitor or official is involved in an accident/incident during or in the vicinity of the event, details must be reported as soon as practicable to the Event Secretary who will complete an Accident Report Form. Please assist/cooperate to ensure all required information is captured.

Road bike category rules:

- No aero bars
- No disc wheels / wheels deeper than 90mm. Wheels must have minimum 12 spokes each.
- Please indicate when signing on if you are competing in the road bike category.
