Course: F2/50



Start at a paint mark about 25 yards short of the expansion joint in the road surface of the bridge where St Neots Road crosses over A428 dual carriageway just west of Highfields Caldecote.

Proceed eastwards straight over (1st exit) Caldecote RAB to Hardwick RAB where sharp left, 1st exit, onto A428 westbound. Pass Cambourne junction to TURN (5.4 miles) at Caxton Gibbet RAB and retrace A428 eastbound passing Cambourne and Hardwick junctions to exit at slip to Madingley RAB (signed Cambridge) **NOTE: NO MARSHAL HERE but THERE WILL BE CTT ARROWS**.

At the roundabout take 4th exit to A428 westbound. Continue past Hardwick and Cambourne junctions to TURN (18.0 miles) at Caxton Gibbet RAB, then repeat via Madingley RAB onto third lap to TURN (30.6 miles) at Caxton Gibbet RAB, then repeat via Madingley RAB onto fourth lap to TURN (43.2 miles) at Caxton Gibbet RAB,

then return to Madingley RAB, but **TAKE THE 3rd EXIT** (the one before the A428 slip) onto St Neots Road to FINISH 0.6 miles along St Neots Road 20 yds after Hardwick 40mph sign.

IMPORTANT: Note that 4th time at Madingley roundabout, when you will have done over 49 miles, you leave earlier to go to the finish. There will be a yellow sign at the relevant point showing the laps/finish routes.

Course Condition / Safety

WARNING!! POTHOLES!!

During the course inspection a number of potholes have been identified on the course. Riders are reminded to ride with their head up and looking forward at all times.

Marshalls: Numerous volunteers will be on the course helping to direct riders. However, it is your responsibility to know the course details and to ride in a safe and courteous manner. Please be mindful and aware of your surroundings at all times.

Lights: The use of FRONT and REAR lights whilst competing is MANDATORY. These lights must be switched on and working at the start of the event. No lights No ride.

Cycling helmets: Cycling Time Trials require ALL COMPETITORS wear a HARD-SHELL HELMET that meets an internationally accepted safety standard. No Helmet No ride.

Litter: Riders are reminded that dropping litter (such as energy gel wrappers) is a criminal offence and offenders will be liable to disciplinary action by the District Committee.

No 'U' Turns: are allowed within sight of either the start or finishing points. Riders carrying out this dangerous manoeuvre are liable for disqualification from the event and further disciplinary action by the District Committee.

Information about Headquarters


Barton Sports & Social Pavillion, Barton. CB23 7BG.

Sign In / Out. All competitors must sign in at HQ and collect their number. Once finished you must return your number to HQ and Sign out. If you do not sign out you will be DQ'd.



Conveniently located just 2km from the M11 and 6km from the start, we have chosen the Barton Sports & Social Pavillion to host our event this year. There is extensive off street parking available, a car parking marshall will be onsite to help direct you. Please be considerate of local residents when parking. Please note bikes are not permitted into the pavilion or past the gate as seen in the photo above.

Changing: The HQ has large and separate changing facilities for men & women.



Directions to the Start

Please leave plenty of time to get to the start line, it is recommended that you leave your car at the Pavillion car park and ride to the start line. The ride should take less than 20 minutes and is straightforward to navigate. There will be signs directing you to the start and also on the return to HQ.

Signing Out / Post Race

Please remember to sign out and return your number, failing to do so will result in disqualification.

Complimentary Tea & Coffee will be available upon your return. Most importantly there will be a **fabulous selection of cakes available** for purchase at just £1.50, cash and card accepted!

A **real time results board** will be available in HQ showing results as riders cross the line. Please note that this is new and experimental software and official times will be reported once ratified by the timekeepers. The timing system is a collaboration between The Shaftesbury and HCS Technologies Ltd. The system will be available for general use soon under the banner of TimeTrialHQ.com.
