## Open 25 Mile Time Trial

**Course:** Old Romney – Brookland – Kingsnorth 2 – Old Romney

Start at western end of layby on A259 near to Oasis diner (TR 033251). Riders should start in the layby at a point opposite the apex of the grass island separating the layby and the A259. Riders should join the A259 and proceed to Brenzett RAB junction of A259/A2070/B2080 (M) left to Brookland RAB. Turn (M) and proceed via Brenzett RAB (4.71 miles). (M) Take 2nd exit onto A.2070 passing straight through Bridgefield RAB (M) to Cloverleaf RAB (13.68 miles).(M) Take second exit to join A2042 to turn at Kingsnorth 2 RAB (14.2 miles)(M) turn rejoining A2042 and fork left within 300 yards(M) to Cloverleaf RAB. Take the first exit onto A2070(M) passing straight through Bridgefield RAB (M) to Brenzett RAB, (23.931 miles) where turn left (M) onto A.259 to finish approx. 25 yards west of access road adjacent to Prospect Bungalow. (25 miles) (TR 018260).

There will be a short prize giving inside the hall after the last rider. Please stay and congratulate the riders picking up prizes tea and cake will be available.

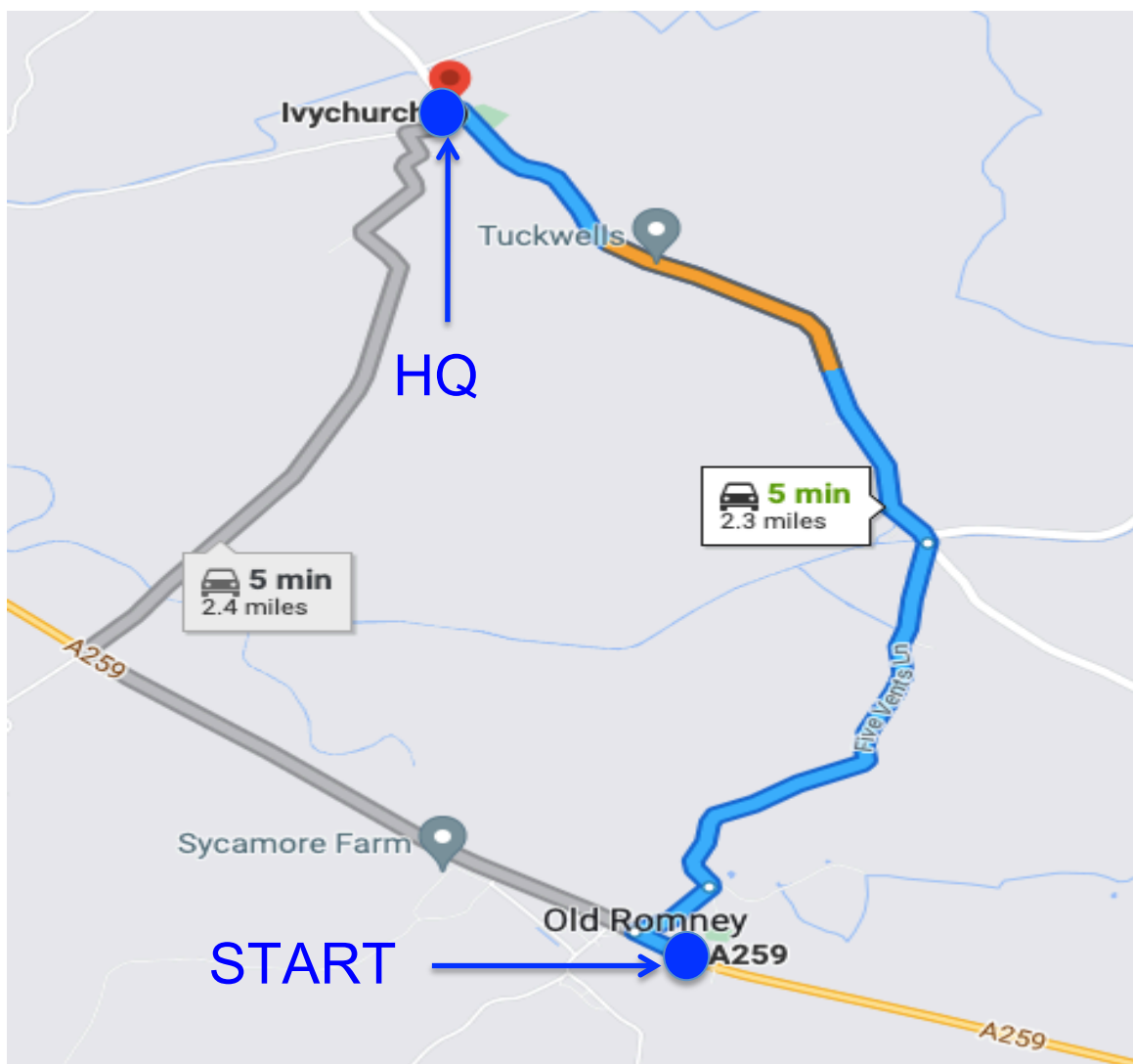

Numbers will be at HQ (and not the start) and may be exchanged for a drink after. Riders are required to sign in before collecting their number and out at the end of the event not to be DQ.

- The **Headquarters** is : Ivychurch Village Hall 6 The Gardens, Ivychurch, Romney Marsh TN29 0AN and will be open from 6 am.
- Competitors must personally sign the signing-in and out at the HQ or they will not be allowed to race. Signing-on and out sheets and race numbers will be at the headquarters.
- Please keep the noise to a minimum to avoid unnecessary disturbance to the local residents.
- **No rider to use a turbo trainer or rollers in the HQ parking area or adjacent roads that are within 50 metres of a domestic property. Anyone failing to comply with this restriction risks disqualification.**
- Competitors or their helpers must not park in the vicinity of the start or finish. Under no circumstances should competitors approach the timekeeper.
- Do not perform U-turns in the Start and Finishing area of the busy A252.
- Allow at least 20minutes to ride to the start point.
- **Directions to the start:** Turn right from the HQ car park and at the “T” Junction by the bell pub turn right onto Ashford rd. Cycle 1.2 miles turn right on to Five Vents Lane. Follow Five Vents Lane for 1 mile to junction of A259. Turn left on to the A259 and the start is in the layby 0.2 miles on the right. Be careful crossing the road.
