

#### Please note

- CTT regulations require the use of a working front and rear light, either flashing or constant. These must be fitted in a position that is visible to other road users and active while the machine is in use.
- Helmets must be worn by all riders.

- You must sign in and out according to CTT regulations. Failure to sign out will result in a DNF. Please also ensure that you return your race number to HQ after your ride.
- Please do not use the course to warm up once the event has started. A suggested route from the HQ to the start and from the finish back to HQ is provided below.
- Please do not ask the timekeepers for your result at the finish area. Results will be posted back at HQ.
- Refreshments will be provided at HQ and there will be a short prize presentation once the last rider is back.

### Start List

### Course map and description

Start at far southern end of bus stop on the A38 at the top of the hill south of Severn Stoke. Ride south on A38 towards Upton on Severn for approx. 1.1 miles


At the traffic island take the second exit to continue on A38 towards Tewkesbury. Continue on A38 for approx. 3.2 miles.

Encircle the traffic island, taking the third exit to retrace A38. Ride north back towards Upton on Severn for approx. 3.2 miles.

At the traffic island take the second exit to continue on A38 towards Worcester. Continue on A38 through Severn Stoke.

\*Please note that the descent into Severn Stoke is quite steep with some sharp bends and a poor road surface. While the worst of the potholes have been repaired it is recommended that you ride this section with caution\*


Finish at the entrance to Tarmac Clifton Quarry.



### Route to start (approx. 4.2 miles)


Although we have a fairly small field of riders, it would be appreciated if riders could follow the route below to get to the start to avoid riding on the course.

Turn left onto Harpley Road and continue over the railway bridge and down the hill to the main road. Turn right onto A4104 heading towards Upton on Severn. At Turnpike Boarding Kennels turn right through Dunstall. Take the next right after the motorway bridge, heading towards Kinnersley. Turn left at the Royal Oak pub and then left onto the A38 at the bottom of the road. Continue up the hill to the start.



#### Route back to HQ (approx. 5.5 miles)

Again, to avoid riding on the course it would be appreciated if riders could follow this route back to the HQ. After the finish, turn around when possible and ride south down A38 back through Severn Stoke village, passing the Rose and Crown pub on the right and Madge Hill on the left. Take the next left towards Kinnersley and then at the end of the road turn right. At the T junction turn left towards Dunstall and then left again just after the boarding kennels onto the A4104. Follow the A4104 towards Pershore, turning left onto Harpley Road just before the road becomes a dual carriageway. Continue on Harpley Road back to HQ.
