- The race takes place on a public highway and the road is open to live traffic so you must always obey the Highway Code and must not impede other road users.
- Marshals are there to indicate direction only; it is your responsibility to give way to other vehicles that have priority at any point on the route. Disruption to other road users should be kept to a minimum.
- PLEASE KEEP YOUR HEAD UP FOR A SAFE RIDE.

025/11 Course details

Start on A18 at north end of lay-by approximately 1/2 mile north of Hatfield Green Tree public house at point marked '25'. Proceed to Tudworth TI (0.4) - take 2nd exit on A18 to Crowle TI (6.6) - encircle island (give way to traffic from left) and retrace to Tudworth TI (13.0) - left on A18 to Green Tree public house (13.9) - left on A614 to Blaxton TI (20.1) encircle island and retrace northwards on A614 towards Hatfield Woodhouse to finish just past 1st lamp post approximately 100yards after Hatfield Woodhouse (25.0).
