Headquarters:	Caldecote Village Hall, Furlong Way, Highfields Caldecote, CB23 7ZH
Course:	Start at paint mark about 25 yards short of expansion joint in road surface of bridge where St Neots Road crosses over A428 dual carriageway just west of Highfields Caldecote. Proceed eastwards straight over (1st exit) Caldecote RAB to Hardwick RAB where sharp left, 1st exit, onto A428 westbound. Pass Cambourne junction to TURN (5.4 miles) at Caxton Gibbett RAB and retrace A428 eastbound passing Cambourne and Hardwick junctions to exit at slip to Madingley RAB (signed Cambridge) <b>NOTE: NO MARSHAL HERE but THERE WILL BE CTT ARROWS</b> . At the roundabout take 4th exit to A428 westbound. Continue past Hardwick and Cambourne junctions to TURN (18.0 miles) at Caxton Gibbett RAB, then repeat via Madingley RAB onto third lap to TURN (30.6 miles) at Caxton Gibbett RAB, then repeat via Madingley RAB onto fourth lap to TURN (43.2 miles) at Caxton Gibbett RAB, then return to Madingley RAB, but TAKE THE 3rd EXIT (the one before the A428 slip) onto St Neots Road to FINISH 0.6 miles along St Neots Road 20 yds after Hardwick 40mph sign.

**PLEASE READ the course details**. Note that 4<sup>th</sup> time at Madingley roundabout, when you will have done over 49 miles, you leave earlier to go to the finish. There will be a yellow sign at the relevant point showing the laps/finish routes.

There will be a lot of riders on the road and some will be riding slowly. Stay alert, stay left.

Approaching Caxton Gibbet RAB it's best to stay in left lane. Don't take outer lane early.

HQ to start:	1.2 miles slightly up-hill. The route will be signed.
Finish to HQ:	Continue on past the finish and bear right to a roundabout where take 1 <sup>st</sup> left. Follow to BP garage and at roundabout take 1 <sup>st</sup> left. The route will be signed.
Parking:	No parking at the finish or on the road close to the start. Parking at the HQ is permitted on the grass. A small car park is located just past the HQ at the sports ground. Nearer the start there is abundant space along the verges of St Neots Road between the start and Cambourne (not on the course).
Warming up:	No warming up along the course by competitors once the event has started. No U-turns in view of the start or the finish. St Neots Road past the start and along to Cambourne roundabout is ideal for warming up.
Rear lights:	A functioning rear light is compulsory: no light = no start. If you discover yours isn't working, ask the Start Official (not the timekeeper) as the club has a supply of spare lights.
Cycling helmets:	CTT and the event promoter strongly advise you wear a hard-shell helmet that meets internationally accepted safety standards.
Numbers:	Will be at the HQ an hour before the first start. When you return your number and sign out you will get a free cuppa! Yes, we're moving back towards normality.
Tea and Cake!:	A free cup of tea for all riders and a free cake also. There will be a pot for donations to the two regional Air Ambulance services (East Anglian Air Ambulance and MAGPAS). You may need their help one day, so be generous!
Results:	Glen Knight will be at the HQ with his instant results screen and results will be available on the day at <u>https://bit.ly/34TJVnv</u> or via QR codes which will be on display at the HQ.
COVID-19:	The HQ will only be used for the WCs. Numbers, signing, tea, cakes and results will all be outside. Please do not mill around at the HQ but leave the area without delay. For signing please wear a mask, bring a pen.

The Viking Road Club Open 50 was one of the classic Essex time trials reliably producing fast times from top riders on the Southend Road and later on the A12. Sadly the event had its last running by Viking RC in the 1990s and in 2017 the club was disbanded. Cambridge CC resurrected the classic event in 2019.

Today we have 3 events in one, four actually including the tandem event. The Viking 50 is a BBAR qualifying event so had to be kept separate from the VTTA event but for the awards, all VTTA members in the Viking 50 are included in the VTTA National Championship and EA VTTA members are all included in the Group Championship. The other way around, everyone in the VTTA Championship is eligible for the cash prizes that apply overall. Complicated, I know – try organising it!
